EXPLANATORY NOTE

Heralded as the "Virgin Boracay of the Philippines", the Island of Malapascua in the Municipality of Daanbantayan in the Province of Cebu has attracted a significant number of local and foreign tourists. The rich biodiversity and colorful heritage of the Island truly reflects the beauty of a paradise that our country should be proud of.

In recognition of its valuable contribution to tourism and economy both in the local and national level; and in view of maximizing its full potential in these aspects, this measure proposes the declaration of the Island of Malapascua as an Eco-Tourism Destination of the Philippines. It mandates the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) and Department of Tourism (DOT) to prepare an eco-tourism master plan to ensure the promotion of tourism, the generation of employment and most importantly, the protection and preservation of the environment and ecosystem.

This measure was submitted in the Fifteenth Congress by the Committees on Environment and Natural Resources, Tourism, and Finance. It was however, not passed into law.

The immediate passage of this bill is earnestly sought.

INTRODUCED BY SEN. JINGGOY EJERCITO ESTRADA

AN ACT

DECLARING THE ISLAND OF MALAPASCUA, PROVINCE OF CEBU AS AN ECO-TOURISM DESTINATION OF THE PHILIPPINES AND FOR OTHER **PURPOSES**

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. State Policy. - It is hereby declared the policy of the State to promote sustainable tourism industry:

Towards that end, the country shall rationalize all efforts pertaining to environmental protection and making the industry a major source of livelihood and an avenue for the generation of employment. Henceforth, aggressive measure seeking to restore the country's share in the Asian tourist market shall be consistent with the preservation of the existing ecosystem and natural environment.

SEC. 2. Pursuant to the public policy, the Island of Malapascua, Province of Cebu is hereby declared an eco-tourism destination of the Philippines.

SEC. 3. Greation of Eco-Tourism Task Force: - Within a year from the approval of this Act, there shall be created an Eco Tourism Task Force whose governing board shall be co-chaired by the Congressman and the Governor of Cebu. The membership of the board shall be composed of representatives from the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR), the Department of Tourism (DOT), the Department of Health (DOH), the private sector, the Non-Governmental Organizations, and the local government units concerned.

SEC. 4. The DENR and DOT shall prepare an eco-tourism master plan and promulgate the necessary rules and regulations to be approved by the President of the Philippines upon recommendation of the board, for implementation by the concerned National Government Agencies and/or Local Government Units.
