



RESOLUTION
COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE ST. PAUL COLLEGE HIMIG
BULILIT CHOIR FOR WINNING THE GOLD MEDAL IN THE CHILDREN'S
CHOIR OPEN CATEGORY OF THE 3RD ASIA PACIFIC CHOIR GAMES HELD
LAST 14 OCTOBER 2013 IN MANADO CITY, INDONESIA

WHEREAS, INTERKULTUR is an international organization that birthed and regularly hosts the renowned World Choir Games, a venue for "peaceful competitions and songs" amongst amateur choirs from all corners of the world, and which is envisioned and fast-becoming a musical network and competitive activity at par with the Olympic games;

WHEREAS, INTERKULTUR launched a regional version of the World Choir Games, namely the Asia Pacific Choir Games, and recently held the 3rd Asia Pacific Choir Games last October 8 to 18, 2013 in Manado City, Indonesia;
