RESOLUTION

COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING RUBILEN DACUA AMIT FOR BRINGING HONOR TO THE PHILIPPINES BY WINNING THE 2013 YALIN WOMEN'S WORLD 10-BALL CHAMPIONSHIP TITLE, AND FOR BEING THE FIRST FEMALE CUEMASTER TO BAG THE CHAMPIONSHIP TITLE TWICE IN THE SAID COMPETITION, CONSIDERED TO BE THE MOST COVETED CHAMPIONSHIP IN WOMEN'S BILLIARDS

WHEREAS, the Yalin Women's World 10-Ball Championship is recognized as the biggest and most coveted women's billiard event in the world. Participated in by world champions from 20 countries, the said competition is said to have the hardest format in women's pool;

WHEREAS, the Philippines hosted the 2013 Yalin Women's World 10-Ball Championship at Resorts World Manila on 04 November 2013, with four Filipino players joining the event, led by Rubilen Amit, the country's top-ranking female cuemaster based on the World Pool-Billiard Association (WPA) world ranking;

WHEREAS, Rubilen Ducas Amit, a member of the Philippine Billiard's team, is an accomplished pool player who has topped various billiards competitions, both local and international. She is a three-time Southeast Asian Games gold medallist and recognized as the Philippines' first woman world pool champion;

WHEREAS, in the recent 2013 Yalin Women's World 10-Ball Championship, Amit bagged the championship title in a hard-fought battle against Britain's number one ranked player, Kelly Fisher;

WHEREAS, Amit had previously reigned in the prestigious competition in 2009, and with her latest triumph, she became the first cuemaster to win the world's most coveted championship in women's billiards twice;

WHEREAS, her latest feat has brought pride and honor to the country, and thus merits the government's recognition;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, that the Senate of the Philippines congratulate and commend Rubilen Ducas Amit for winning the 2013 Yalin Women's World 10-ball Championship title, and for being the first female cuemaster to bag the championship title twice in the said competition, considered to be the most coveted championship in women's billiards.
