RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the 3rd Asia-Pacific Choir Games, organized by InterKultur Germany, is considered as one of the most prestigious choral contests in Asia;

WHEREAS, it is the first time that the Philippines, through the Himig Bulilit Choir of St. Paul College of Parañaque, has emerged as Champion in the Asia-Pacific Choir Games on October 10 to 15, 2013;
