RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THE DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT TO EXPAND THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CASH-FOR-WORK PROGRAM TO INCLUDE FAMILIES AFFECTED BY TYPHOON "YOLANDA" (HAIYAN)

WHEREAS, typhoon "Yolanda" (Haiyan) devastated the country and has affected a total of 1,962,898 families. Out of the total affected, 314,936 families were displaced and served both inside and outside evacuation centers¹;

WHEREAS, typhoon "Yolanda" has left families homeless and without food, clean water and livelihood;

WHEREAS, the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) has implemented cash-for-work (CFW) program to support families affected by the typhoons "Pedring," "Quiel,"² "Sendong"³ and the armed-conflict in Zamboanga⁴;

WHEREAS, CFW is a relief effort that provides cash in exchange for community service which include, among others, maintaining the cleanliness of evacuation centers, repair and reconstruction of damaged houses and community facilities, clean-up and garbage collection, declogging of drainages and assistance in the clearing operation;

WHEREAS, CFW will help victims of typhoon "Yolanda" to restore not only their livelihood but human dignity as well;

- (3) urges the DSWD, other concerned government agencies, and local government units to coordinate efforts in the implementation of the CFW program to support families affected by typhoon "Yolanda"; and
- (4) encourages private citizens to assist in the implementation of the CFW program.
