RESOLUTION

EXPRESSING THE SENSE OF THE SENATE IN COMMENDING AND THANKING VARIOUS COUNTRIES AND FOREIGN ORGANIZATIONS AROUND THE WORLD FOR ASSISTING AND LENDING A HELPING HAND TO THE PHILIPPINES AFTER THE ONSLAUGHT OF TYPHOON YOLANDA

WHEREAS, Typhoon Yolanda (international name Haiyan), a tropical storm said to be the one of the most powerful in history, battered Eastern Visayas, particularly the provinces of Leyte and Samar.
