AN ACT DECLARING AUGUST 9 AS NATIONAL INDIGENOUS PEOPLES DAY AND MANDATING THE MEANINGFUL OBSERVANCE THEREOF

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in congress assembled:

- SECTION 1. It is hereby declared a policy of the government to advance
- 2 the rights and collective well-being of indigenous peoples through the annual
- 3 observance of the National Indigenous Peoples in the Philippines.
- 4 SEC. 2. The National Indigenous Peoples Day in the Philippines shall be observed on
- 5 August 9 of each year and is hereby declared a special working holiday.
- 6 SEC. 3. The National Commission on Indigenous Peoples shall promulgate the
- 7 rules and regulations for the meaningful observance of the National Indigenous Peoples
- 8 Day.
- 9 SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the official
- 10 Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
