BE KNOWN AS NATIONAL CHILDREN'S DAY"**

Senate Bill No. 485, introduced by Senator Antonio F. Trillanes IV, entitled:

**"AN ACT
DECLARING NOVEMBER 20 OF EVERY YEAR AS NATIONAL CHILDREN'S DAY"**

and House Bill No. 1641, introduced by Reps. Yap (S.), Enerio-Cerilles, Antonino-Nadres, *et al*, entitled:

**"AN ACT
DECLARING THE CELEBRATION OF THE NATIONAL CHILDREN'S MONTH IN THE
COUNTRY IN OCTOBER EVERY YEAR"**

have considered the same and have the honor to report back to the Senate with the recommendation that S. No. 332, taking into consideration S. No. 485 and H. No. 1641, be approved with the following amendments:

1. "SECTION 3. All learning levels of educational institutions, both public and private, shall celebrate the Day in simple ceremonies and hold appropriate activities THROUGHOUT THE MONTH with emphasis on inculcating in the minds of the students a *children's rights culture* that aims for a sustainable youth development in the country."
2. "SECTION 4. All private enterprises are encouraged to observe National Children's Day in simple rites and participate in MONTH-LONG activities based on their discretion."

3. "SECTION 5. The Council for the Welfare of Children (CWC) shall take the lead in the MONTH-LONG celebration of the National Children's Day."
