

Mr. President:

The Committee on Finance to which was referred House Bill No. 5237 introduced by Speaker Feliciano Belmonte, Jr., Representatives Isidro T. Ungab and Neptali M. Gonzales II, ^{et. al.} *entitled:* 

**"AN ACT
APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF TWENTY-TWO BILLION FOUR
HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN MILLION SIX HUNDRED EIGHT THOUSAND
PESOS (P22,467,608,000) AS SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS
FOR FY 2014 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES"**

has considered the same and has the honor to report them back to the Senate with the recommendation that House Bill No. 5237 be approved with the following amendments:




2. On page 4, line 3, between the words "budgeting" and "laws" insert a comma (,) and the phrase **ACCOUNTING AND AUDITING**; and





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
