AN ACT FOR AN ELDERLY AND VISUALLY IMPAIRED FRIENDLY PHILIPPINE CURRENCY DESIGN, AMENDING SECTION 53 OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 7653

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Section 53 of Republic Act No. 7653, otherwise known as 2 the New Central Bank Act, is hereby amended to read as follows: 3 "SEC. 53. Characteristics of the Currency, The 4 Monetary Board, with the approval of the President of the 5 Philippines, shall prescribe the denominations, dimensions, designs, inscriptions and other characteristics of notes issued by the 6 Bangko Sentral: Provided, however, That said notes shall state that 7 they are liabilities of the Bangko Sentral and are fully guaranteed 8 9 by the Government of the Republic of the Philippines. Said notes 10 shall bear the signatures, in facsimile, of the President of the 11 Philippines and of the Governor of the Bangko Sentral.

"Similarly, the Monetary Board, with the approval of the President of the Philippines, shall prescribe the weight, fineness, designs, denominations and other characteristics of the coins issued by the Bangko Sentral. In the minting of coins, the Monetary Board shall give full consideration to the availability of suitable metals and to their relative prices and cost of minting.

"ADDITIONALLY, ALL THESE NOTES SHALL BEAR FEATURES EASILY DISTINGUISHABLE TO THE ELDERLY AND THE VISUALLY IMPAIRED BY ENSURING THAT EACH CURRENCY DENOMINATION, WHETHER NOTES OR COINS, SHALL HAVE DIFFERENT SIZES OR DESIGNS AND THAT EACH NOTE SHALL HAVE RAISED DOTS OR MARKINGS TO SIGNIFY ITS DENOMINATION. THE MONETARY BOARD SHALL ALWAYS CONSIDER THE ELDERLY AND THE DIFFERENTLY ABLED WHEN DESIGNING NOTES AND COINS."

SEC. 2. Separability Clause. — If any provision or section of this Act or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held unconstitutional or invalid, the other provisions or sections of this Act, and the application of such provision or section to other person's circumstances, shall not be affected thereby.

SEC. 3. Effectivity. — This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days following its publication in the Official Gazette or in two (2) national newspapers of general circulation.
