AN ACT CREATING A BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY H-2 IN THE CITY OF DASMARIÑAS, PROVINCE OF CAVITE

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Creation of Barangay H-2. – There is hereby created a barangay to be known as Barangay H-2 in the City of Dasmariñas, Province of Cavite.

SEC. 2. Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite. – The plebiscite conducted and supervised by the Commission on Elections (COMELEC) pursuant to Provincial Ordinance No. 2000-004 of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of the Province of Cavite, which ratified the creation of Barangay H-2 as proclaimed by the Plebiscite Board of Canvassers on October 19, 2003, shall serve as substantial compliance with the plebiscite requirement under Section 10 of Republic Act No. 7160, as amended, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991".

SEC. 3. Incumbent Barangay Officials. - The incumbent barangay officials of Barangay H-2, City of Dasmariñas, Province of Cavite shall

1	continue to hold office until such time that their successors have been duly
2	elected and qualified.
3	SEC. 4. Public Infrastructures and Facilities All existing public
4	infrastructures and facilities for public use existing therein at the time of the
5	approval of this Act are hereby transferred without cost or compensation to
6	and shall be administered by the new barangay.
7	SEC. 5. Internal Revenue Allotment Shares Barangay H-2 shall be
8	entitled to Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) shares pursuant to Section 285 of
9	Republic Act No. 7160, as amended, otherwise known as the "Local
10	Government Code of 1991".
11	SEC. 6. Separability Clause If, for any reason, any part or
12	provision of this Act is declared unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or
13	provisions which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and
14	effect.
15	SEC. 7. Effectivity This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
16	its publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
