EXPANDING THE DEFINITION OF SURVIVORS OF AFP MILITARY PERSONNEL ENTITLED TO RETIREMENT AND SEPARATION BENEFITS, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE PRESIDENTIAL DECREE NO. 1638

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Presidential Decree (P.D.) No. 1638, otherwise known as "Establishing a New System of Retirement and Separation for Military Personnel of the Armed Forces of the Philippines and for Other Purposes," enumerates benefits for military retirees, and the conditions for entitlement.

P.D. No. 1638 grants monthly annuities to survivors of the military retirees as well. These are the (1) surviving spouse, (2) surviving and unmarried legitimate, adopted and acknowledged children below 21 years of age, and (3) in default of the spouse and children below 21 years of age, children 21 years of age and above, or surviving parents, or surviving unmarried siblings.

This bill seeks to expand the definition of survivors in the Decree for two purposes. First, it promotes the trend in our welfare legislation of amelioration and declassification of illegitimate children by giving them rights equal to the legitimate children. Second, it reinforces the intent of the Decree to provide

dependents of military retirees support by including in the definition those who need the benefits the most, particularly children who are incapacitated.
