AN ACT

REDUCING THE RETIREMENT AGE OF SURFACE MINE WORKERS FROM SIXTY (60) TO FIFTY (50) YEARS 293 PURPOSE AMENDING FOR THE ARTICLE OF PRESIDENTIAL DECREE NO. 442, AS AMENDED, OTHERWISE **KNOWN AS THE LABOR CODE OF THE PHILIPPINES**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1	SECTION 1. Article 293 of Presidential Decree No. 442, as amended,
2	otherwise known as the Labor Code of the Philippines, is hereby amended to
3	read as follows:

5	"ARTICLE 293. Retirement Any employee may be retired
6	upon reaching the retirement age established in the collective

bargaining agreement or other applicable employment contract.

"In case of retirement, the employee shall be entitled to receive such retirement benefits as he may have earned under existing laws and any collective bargaining agreement and other 1

agreements: Provided, however, That an employee's retirement benefits under any collective bargaining and other agreements shall not be less than those provided herein.

"In the absence of a retirement plan or agreement providing I. for retirement benefits of employees in the establishment, an employee upon reaching the age of sixty (60) years or more, but not beyond sixty-five (65) years which is hereby declared the compulsory retirement age, who has served at least five (5) years in the said establishment, may retire and shall be entitled to 10 retirement pay equivalent to at least one-half (1/2) month salary for 11 every year of service, a fraction of at least six (6) months being 12 considered as one whole year. 13

"Unless the parties provide for broader inclusions, the term 15 'one-half (1/2) month salary' shall mean fifteen (15) days plus one-16 twelfth (1/12) of the 13th month pay and the cash equivalent of not 17 more than five (5) days of service incentive leaves. 18

"An underground OR SURFACE mining employee upon 20 reaching the age of fifty (50) years or more, but not beyond sixty 21 (60) years which is hereby declared the compulsory retirement age 22 for BOTH underground AND SURFACE mine workers, who has 23 served at least five (5) years as underground OR SURFACE mine 24

worker may retire and shall be entitled to all the retirement benefits 1 2 provided for in this Article. **"FOR PURPOSES OF THIS ACT, SURFACE MINE** 3 WORKERS SHALL INCLUDE 4 MILL PLANT WORKERS. 5 ELECTRICAL, MECHANICAL AND TAILINGS POND 6 PERSONNEL. 7 8 "Retail, service and agricultural establishments or 9 operations employing not more than ten (10) employees or workers are exempted from the coverage of this provision. 10 11 "Violation of this provision is hereby declared unlawful and 12 13 subject to the penal provisions provided under Article 288 of this Code. 14 15 "Nothing in this Article shall deprive any employee of 16 benefits to which he may be entitled under SECTION 12-B OF 17 REPUBLIC ACT NO. 1161, AS AMENDED, OTHERWISE 18 KNOWN AS THE SOCIAL SECURITY ACT OF 1997 AND 19 OTHER existing laws or company policies or practices." 20 21 SEC. 2. Renumbering. - For purposes of uniformity, the numerical 22 designation of Title II (Retirement), Book Six of Presidential Decree No. 442, as 23 24 Article 293 in Section 1 of this Act, shall be renumbered in accordance with

25 Republic Act No. 10151.

SEC. 3. *Implementing Rules and Regulations.* – Within thirty (30) days from the effectivity of this Act, the Secretary of Labor and Employment shall, in consultation and coordination with the President of the Social Security System, promulgate the necessary rules and regulations for the effective implementation of this Act.

SEC. 4. *Repealing Clause.* – Section 12-B of Republic Act No. 1161, as amended, otherwise known as the *Social Security Act of 1997*, is hereby amended and modified accordingly to entitle underground or surface mining employees to the benefits provided therein upon reaching the retirement age of fifty (50) years old. All other laws, decrees, executive orders, proclamations, rules and regulations, and other issuances or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SEC. 5. *Effectivity Clause*. – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days
after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
