



AN ACT DIVIDING BARANGAY TANGOS IN THE CITY OF NAVOTAS  
INTO TWO (2) DISTINCT AND INDEPENDENT BARANGAYS  
TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY TANGOS NORTH AND  
BARANGAY TANGOS SOUTH

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in  
Congress assembled:*

1           SECTION 1. *Division of Barangay Tangos.* – Barangay Tangos in the  
2 City of Navotas is hereby divided into two (2) distinct and independent  
3 barangays to be known as Barangay Tangos North and Barangay Tangos  
4 South.

5           SEC. 2. *Territorial Boundaries.* – The territorial boundaries of each  
6 barangay created in the immediately preceding section shall be as follows:

7           (1) Barangay Tangos North

8           “Bounded on the Northwest (NW) and Northeast (NE) by  
9 Malabon-Navotas River;

10           On the Southeast (SE) by centerline of Ferry #5r; and

11           On the Southeast (SE) by centerline of M. Naval Street, and Manila  
12 Bay;

13           Containing an area of 212,964.02 square meters, more or less”.

1 (2) Barangay Tangos South

2 "Bounded on the Northwest (NW) and Northeast (NE) by centerline of  
3 M. Naval Street;

4 On the Southeast (SE) by centerline of Manalaysay Street, and Lots  
5 4260 and 4261 (Andres Pascua), 4264, 4263, and 4252 all of Barangay  
6 San Roque, Navotas Cadastral Mapping MCadm 582-D Case 12; and

7 On the Southwest (SW) by Manila Bay;

8 Containing an area of 151,537.72 square meters, more or less".

9 SEC. 3. *Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite.* – The Commission on  
10 Elections (COMELEC) shall conduct and supervise the plebiscite to be held in  
11 Barangay Tangos in the City of Navotas within thirty (30) days from the  
12 effectivity of this Act.

13 The expenses for such plebiscite shall be borne by the City of Navotas.

14 SEC. 4. *Special Election of Barangay Officials.* – The first set of  
15 barangays officials created under Section 1 hereof shall be elected not later  
16 than ninety (90) days from approval by majority votes cast in a plebiscite held  
17 for the purpose.

18 The COMELEC shall conduct and supervise the special elections to be  
19 held in Barangay Tangos North and Barangay Tangos South in the City of  
20 Navotas within sixty (60) days after the ratification of this Act in a plebiscite.

21 The expenses for such special elections shall be borne by the City of  
22 Navotas.

23 SEC. 5. *Incumbent Barangay Officials.* – The incumbent barangay  
24 officials of Barangay Tangos shall continue to hold office and administer  
25 Barangay Tangos North and Barangay Tangos South until such time that the  
26 officials of the newly created barangays have been duly elected and qualified.

27 SEC. 6. *Public Infrastructures and Facilities* – All existing public  
28 infrastructures and facilities for public use existing therein at the time of the

1 approval of this Act are hereby transferred without cost or compensation to and  
2 shall be administered by the new barangays.

3 SEC. 7. *Internal Revenue Allotment Shares.* – Barangay Tangos North  
4 and Barangay Tangos South in the City of Navotas shall be entitled to Internal  
5 Revenue Allotment (IRA) shares pursuant to Section 285 of Republic Act No.  
6 7160, as amended, otherwise known as the “Local Government Code of 1991”.

7 SEC. 8. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after  
8 its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in any newspaper of general  
9 circulation.
