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AN ACT MANDATING A TWO THOUSAND PESO (P2,000)
ACROSS-THE-BOARD INCREASE IN THE MONTHLY PENSION
WITH CORRESPONDING ADJUSTMENT OF THE MINIMUM
MONTHLY PENSION UNDER THE SOCIAL SECURITY SYSTEM,
AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE SECTION 12 OF REPUBLIC
ACT NO. 1161, AS AMENDED, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE
"SOCIAL SECURITY ACT OF 1997"

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Any provision of law to the contrary notwithstanding, the 1 Social Security Commission is hereby mandated to implement a Two thousand 2 3 peso (P2,000) across-the-board increase in the monthly pension under the 4 Social Security System. SEC. 2. Section 12 of Republic Act No. 1161, as amended by Republic 5 6 Act No. 8282, is hereby further amended to read as follows: "SEC. 12. Monthly Pension. - (a) The monthly pension 7 shall be the highest of the following amounts: "(1) The sum of the following:

1	"(i) Three hundred pesos (P300); plus					
2	"(ii) Twenty percent (20%) of the average monthly salary					
3	credit; plus					
4	"(iii) Two percent (2%) of the average monthly salary					
5	credit for each credited year of service in excess of ten (10)					
6	years; or					
7	"(2) Forty percent (40%) of the average monthiy salary					
8	credit; or					
9	"(3) One thousand pesos (P1,000): Provided, That the					
10	monthly pension shall in no case be paid for an aggregate amount					
11	of less than sixty (60) months.					
12	"(b) Notwithstanding the preceding paragraph, the					
13	minimum MONTILLY pension shall be [One thousand two					
14	hundred pesos (P1,200)] THREE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED					
15	(P3,200) for members with at least ten (10) credited years of					
16	service and [Two thousand four hundred pesos (P2,400)] FOUR					
17	THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED PESOS (P4,400) for those with					
18	twenty (20) credited years of service."					
19	SEC. 3. Any law, presidential decree or issuance, executive order, letter					
20	of instruction, administrative order, rule, or regulation inconsistent with this					
21	Act is hereby repealed, modified, or amended accordingly.					
22	SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication					
23	in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
