AN ACT INCREASING THE BED CAPACITY OF THE DR. RAFAEL S. TUMBOKON MEMORIAL HOSPITAL IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF KALIBO, PROVINCE OF AKLAN FROM ONE HUNDRED SIXTY-TWO (162) TO FOUR HUNDRED (400) BEDS AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:*

1           SECTION 1. The authorized bed capacity of the Dr. Rafael S.  
2 Tumbokon Memorial Hospital (DRSTMH), in the Municipality of Kalibo,  
3 Province of Aklan is hereby increased from one hundred sixty-two (162) to  
4 *four hundred (400) beds.*

5           The Provincial Government of Aklan shall implement the increase in  
6 bed capacity of the DRSTMH for a period of not more than three (3) years  
7 from the approval of this Act.

8           SEC. 2. The existing service capability, professional health care  
9 services, and health human resource of the DRSTMH shall be upgraded and  
10 increased to conform to and be commensurate with the increase in authorized  
11 bed capacity as herein provided.

1           SEC. 3. The Provincial Government of Aklan shall provide the  
2 necessary funds to support the increase in bed capacity of the DRSTMH and  
3 the corresponding upgrading of its facilities and services. The Secretary of  
4 Health shall include in the Department's subsidy program its support for the  
5 capital outlay requirements of the hospital.

6           SEC. 4. The Provincial Government of Aklan, in coordination with the  
7 Department of Health, shall promulgate the necessary rules and regulations for  
8 the effective implementation of this Act.

9           SEC. 5. Republic Act No. 7589, entitled "An Act Increasing the Bed  
10 Capacity of the Dr. Rafael Tumbokon Memorial Hospital in the Municipality  
11 of Kalibo, Province of Aklan, from One Hundred (100) to One Hundred Fifty  
12 (150) Beds, and Appropriating Funds Therefor", is hereby repealed. All other  
13 laws, decrees, orders, issuances, rules and regulations and parts thereof which  
14 are inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed, amended,  
15 or modified accordingly.

16           SEC. 6. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication  
17 in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
