





BUKIDNON FROM THE HALAPITAN NATIONAL HIGH
SCHOOL, CONVERTING IT INTO AN INDEPENDENT
NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL TO BE KNOWN AS LITTLE BAGUIO
NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS
THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. The Halapitan National High School – Little Baguio
2 Annex in Barangay Little Baguio, Municipality of San Fernando, Province of
3 Bukidnon is hereby separated from the Halapitan National High School and
4 converted into an independent national high school to be known as Little
5 Baguio National High School.

6 SEC. 2. All personnel, assets, liabilities and records of the Halapitan
7 National High School – Little Baguio Annex are hereby transferred to and
8 absorbed by the Little Baguio National High School.

9 SEC. 3. The Secretary of Education shall immediately include in the
10 Department's program the operationalization of the Little Baguio National

1 High School, the initial funding of which shall be charged against the current
2 year's appropriation of the Halapitan National High School -- Little Baguio
3 Annex. Thereafter, the amount necessary for the continued operation of the
4 school shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

5 SEC. 4. The Secretary of Education shall issue such rules and
6 regulations as may be necessary to carry out the purpose of this Act.

7 SEC. 5. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication
8 in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
