WHEREAS, he had risen to prominence when he became a member of the Agrava Fact-Finding Board who investigated the assassination of former Senator, Benigno "Ninoy" Aquino<sup>5</sup>;

WHEREAS, one of the most notable of highlight of his illustrious career in public service, is the landmark reforms in vocational education training which resulted to the creation of Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA)<sup>6</sup>;

WHEREAS, his life as a legislator focused in furthering laws on labor, employment, fiscal, education, anti-drugs, and law and order<sup>7</sup>;
