AN ACT DECLARING MAY 15 OF EVERY YEAR A SPECIAL
NONWORKING HOLIDAY IN THE ENTIRE PROVINCE OF
SURIGAO DEL NORTE TO BE KNOWN AS "ADLAW NAN
PROBINSYA NAN SURIGAO", REPEALING FOR THE PURPOSE
REPUBLIC ACT NO. 7553, ENTITLED "AN ACT DECLARING
JUNE NINETEEN OF EVERY YEAR AS A SPECIAL
NONWORKING HOLIDAY IN THE PROVINCE OF SURIGAO
DEL NORTE, TO BE KNOWN AS 'ADLAW NAN SURIGAO DEL
NORTE' "

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. May 15 of every year is declared a special nonworking
2 holiday in the entire Province of Surigao del Norte to be known as "Adlaw
3 Nan Probinsya Nan Surigao".

4 SEC. 2. Republic Act No. 7553, entitled "An Act Declaring June
5 Nineteen of Every Year as a Special Nonworking Holiday in the Province of
6 Surigao del Norte, to be known as "Adlaw Nan Surigao del Norte", is hereby
7 repealed.

8 SEC. 3. All laws, executive orders, decrees, rules and regulations and
9 other issuances inconsistent with any provision of this Act are hereby deemed
10 amended and modified accordingly.

1 SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication
2 in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
