





AN ACT CONVERTING THE BENTUCO HIGH SCHOOL IN
BARANGAY BENTUCO, MUNICIPALITY OF GUBAT,
PROVINCE OF SORSOGON INTO A NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL
TO BE KNOWN AS BENTUCO NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL AND
APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

- 1 SECTION 1. The Bentuco High School in Barangay Bentuco,
2 Municipality of Gubat, Province of Sorsogon is hereby converted into a
3 national high school to be known as Bentuco National High School.
- 4 SEC. 2. All personnel, assets, liabilities and records of the Bentuco
5 High School are hereby transferred to and absorbed by the Bentuco National
6 High School.
- 7 SEC. 3. The Secretary of Education shall immediately include in the
8 Department's program the operationalization of the Bentuco National High
9 School, the initial funding of which shall be charged against the current year's
10 appropriation of the Bentuco High School. Thereafter, the amount necessary

1 for the continued operation of the school shall be included in the annual
2 General Appropriations Act.

3 SEC. 4. The Secretary of Education shall issue rules and regulations
4 necessary to carry out the purpose of this Act.

5 SEC. 5. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication
6 in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
