AN ACT DECLARING APRIL 27 OF EVERY YEAR AS A SPECIAL WORKING PUBLIC HOLIDAY THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY TO COMMEMORATE THE VICTORY OF LAPU-LAPU AND HIS MEN OVER THE SPANIARDS LED BY FERDINAND MAGELLAN IN THE HISTORIC BATTLE OF MACTAN ON APRIL 27, 1521, TO BE KNOWN AS LAPU-LAPU DAY OR ADLAW NI LAPU-LAPU

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- 1 SECTION 1. Lapu-Lapu Day. The twenty-
- 2 seventh (27th) day of April of every year is hereby declared
- 3 as a special working public holiday throughout the country
- 4 to commemorate the victory of Lapu-Lapu and his men over
- 5 the Spaniards in the historic battle of Mactan on April 27,
- 6 1521, to be known as Lapu-Lapu Day or Adlaw ni Lapu-
- 7 Lapu.

1	SEC. 2. Repealing Clause. – All laws, decrees,
2	orders, rules and regulations or other issuances or parts
3	thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are
4	hereby repealed or modified accordingly.
5	SEC. 3. Effectivity. – This Act shall take effect after
6	fifteen (15) days following the completion of its publication
7	either in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general
