

AN ACT TO GIVE JURIDICAL PERSONALITY TO THE PRESENT VETERANS MEMORIAL MEDICAL CENTER (VMMC) AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

EXPLANATORY NOTE

In recognition of the heroism exemplified by our Filipino soldiers during World War II, the 80th Congress of the United States of America passed Public Land Law 865 on 8 July 1948 which provided \$9.4 million for the construction and establishment of a hospital facility presently known as the Veterans Memorial Medical Center. (VMMC)¹

The VMMC is mandated, among others, to provide the best possible medical care and treatment to eligible veterans and their dependents.² This, however, may not be fully realized as the hospital is primarily dependent on the available funds appropriated by the national government. Under the General Appropriations Act of 2016, the hospital's total budget allocation for FY 2016 is One billion, sixty-eight million, eighty-five thousand pesos (P1,068,085,000.00). This amount represents a measly .91% of the total budget of the Department of National Defense (DND).

Under this proposed measure, it is hereby declared the policy of the State to strengthen, promote and support the undertaking of the VMMC in order to render premium medical services to the veterans and their dependents through a comprehensive health care system characterized by excellence, dedication and commitment

In order to achieve this avowed policy, this bill primarily seeks to provide juridical personality to the present VMMC to preserve its viability and continued existence. It is also provided in the bill that a Board of Trustees composed of five (5) members shall govern, direct and control and manage the activities of the VMMC.


In view of the foregoing, immediate passage of this bill is earnestly requested.

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Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

AN ACT

TO GIVE JURIDICAL PERSONALITY TO THE PRESENT VETERANS MEMORIAL MEDICAL CENTER (VMMC) AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

SECTION 1. Short Title. - This act shall be known as "The Veterans Memorial
 Medical Center Charter Act of 2016."

SECTION 2. Declaration of Policy. - It is hereby declared the policy of the State to
 help foster the socioeconomic security and general well-being of the country's veterans
 and retired military personnel.

6 In recognition of their patriotic services in the times of war and peace for the cause 7 of freedom and democracy, it is hereby declared the policy of the State to strengthen, 8 promote and support the undertaking of the medical center in order to render premium 9 medical services to the veterans and their dependents through a comprehensive health 10 care system characterized by excellence, dedication and commitment.

SECTION 3. Veterans Memorial Medical Center (VMMC) as a Corporate Entity.
 There is hereby created a body corporate, for the benefit primarily of the Filipino
 veterans, under the name of the Veterans Memorial Medical Center, hereinafter referred
 to as the VMMC.

SECTION 4. Purposes and Objectives of the Hospital. - The VMMC shall have
 the following objectives:

- 17 (a) Construct, establish, operate and maintain veterans' hospital primarily for
 18 the veterans' welfare;
- (b) Stimulate and/or undertake scientific researches on the biological,
 demographic, social, economic, eugenic, physiological aspects of health
 disorders and abnormalities and their control; and gather, compile,
 present and publish the findings of such researches for public
 dissemination;

- (c) Facilitate and encourage the dissemination and exchange of ideas and information on the prevention, treatment and control of diseases; to arouse, enhance and develop public interest and awareness on general health and physical fitness;
- (d) Encourage and/or undertake the training of physicians, nurses, medical technologists, health officers and social workers on the practical and scientific conduct and implementation and delivery of health services, and related activities;
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 (e) Assist universities, hospitals and research institutions in their studies of health problems, to encourage advanced training on matters of, or affecting the physical and mental well-being of the people;

- 12 (f) Encourage the formation of other organizations on the national, provincial, 13 city, municipal or barangay level and to coordinate their various efforts 14 and activities for the purpose of achieving a more effective and pragmatic 15 approach on the common problems relative to the objectives herein 16 enumerated; and
- 17 (g) Extend medical outreach treatment to the general public to help prevent, 18 relive or alleviate the innumerable afflictions and maladies of the people 19 especially the poor and the less fortunate in life without regard to race, 20 creed, color or political belief.

SECTION 5. Social Responsibility. - The VMMC is primarily committed to serve
 the Filipino veterans as defined in Republic Act No. 6948, as amended by Republic Act
 No. 7696 and Republic Act No. 9396.

SECTION 6. Corporate Powers. - For the attainment of the above purposes and objectives, the VMMC, as a corporate body, acting through its Board of Trustees, shall have all the powers pertaining to a juridical person, and is therefore authorized:

- 27 (a) To have continuous succession under its corporate name, until otherwise
 28 provided by law;
- 29 (b) To prescribe, adopt, amend and/or repeal its bylaws;
- 30 (c) To sue and be sued;
- 31 (d) To acquire, receive, take and hold by request, devise, gift, purchase or 32 lease, either absolutely or in trust for any of its purposes, from foreign and 33 domestic sources, any asset, grant or property, real or personal, subject to 34 such limitations as are provided in existing laws; to convey or dispose of 35 such assets, grants or properties, movable and immovable; and invest 36 and/or reinvest such proceeds and deal with and expand its assets and 37 income in such a manner as will best promote its objectives;
- 38 (e) To enter into contracts;

- 1 (f) To solicit and receive donations, endowments and funds in the form of 2 contributions, whether in cash or in kind, from both the public and private 3 sectors;
 - (g) To open such accounts in banks and other financial institutions, and to disburse such funds or invest the same as the Board may direct to accomplish or advance the purpose or interest of the VMMC;
 - (h) To invite foreign health specialists and other similar experts in the various medical fields to train the personnel or trainer or residents of the VMMC;
- 9 (i) To send the VMMC personnel to research institutes, medical institutes, or 10 universities for advance training or observation and to attend international 11 or regional conventions, conferences, congresses and seminars, as the 12 Board may deem necessary, to accomplish the purposes and objectives of 13 the VMMC;
- 14(j)To enter into such agreements and arrangements with other medical or15other institutions, domestic or foreign, as may be deemed desirable by the16Board, for the purpose of promoting its purposes and objectives;
- 17(k)To establish branches of the VMMC in other provinces or cities of the18Philippines as my be deemed necessary for greater service coverage to19veterans and their dependents that are living in almost all parts of the20country; and
- (I) To exercise such powers and perform such duties as may be necessary to
 carry out the business and purposes for which the VMMC was established
 or which, from time to time, may be declared by the Board of Trustees to
 be necessary, useful, incidental or auxiliary to accomplish such purposes.

25 **SECTION 7. Board of Trustees. -** The VMMC shall be governed and its activities 26 be directed, controlled and managed by a Board of Trustees, hereinafter referred to as 27 the Board. It shall be composed of five (5) members who shall be appointed by the 28 President of the Philippines. The Board shall be made up of the following:

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(a) Medical Director of the VMMC;

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(b) Two (2) members from the government sector;

31 32 (c) Two (2) veteran members who are of good moral character, of unquestionable integrity, of known probity and patriotism.

The term of office of each member shall for a period of three (3) years. In case of vacancy, such vacancy shall be filled in the same manner as provided for the predecessor, and such appointee shall hold office for the unexpired term only.

36 **SECTION 8. Meetings and Quorum.** - The Board of Trustees shall convene at least 37 once a month. The members shall elect from among themselves who will serve as 38 Chairperson of the Board. The Chairperson of the Board my call a special meeting

whenever necessary; Provided, That the members are notified in writing at least three (3) days prior to the said meeting. A majority of all the members of the Board holding office at the time the meeting is called shall constitute a quorum for Board meetings. In no case shall any and all members of the Board appoint a representative to act on their behalf.

6 The decisions of the Board shall be made by a vote of the majority of all its 7 members.

8 SECTION 9. Medical Director. - The Medical Director shall be appointed by the 9 President of the Philippines upon the recommendation of the Board and shall serve for 10 a term of six (6) years. The Medical Director shall act as the Chief Executive Officer of 11 the VMMC and shall perform the following functions:

- (a) Organize the VMMC into a streamlined medical institution with admirable
 facilities and competent staff to ensure quality service;
- (b) Appoint members of the professional and administrative staff and other
 employees or personnel of the VMMC through a screening process based
 strictly on academic qualifications, experiences and other selection
 standards; determine the terms and conditions of their employment, and
 remove them for cause in accordance with law and due process;
- 19(c)Determine a position qualifications and compensation plan and adjust20salaries and benefits for all personnel of the VMMC, subject to the21Compensation and Position Classification System of Governance22Commission for the GOCCs; and
- (d) Carry out necessary managerial and administrative functions that may be
 deemed necessary or as directed by the Board of Trustees in furtherance
 of the objectives of the VMMC set in this Act.

SECTION 10. Secretary. - There shall be a Secretary of the VMMC to be appointed
 by the Board of Trustees, who shall be the Secretary of the Board and who shall keep
 such records of the hospital as may be designated by the Board.

SECTION 11. Hospital Executive Committee. - There shall be an Executive Committee consisting of the Medical Director as the presiding officer and the Heads of the Administrative, Medical, Surgical, Rehabilitative, Dental, Psychiatric, Diagnostic and other critical medical departments. The Committee shall exercise the following functions:

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- (a) Fix the requirement for admission to the hospital;
- (b) Prescribe the rules and regulations as to the discharge of patients;
- 36 (c) Adopt internal rules of procedures consistent with the provision of the Charter
 37 in order to promote administrative efficiency in the treatment, rehabilitation
 38 and discharge of patients of the hospitals; and

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(d) Carry out administrative and managerial task to assist the Medical Director in the efficient operations and management of the hospital.

3 SECTION 12. Personnel and Medical Staff- The VMMC shall have the autonomy 4 to employ such employees and medical personnel, or otherwise enter such arrangements with medical specialist and other consultants as its Board of Trustees 5 shall determine. The personnel and medical staff of the present VMMC shall 6 7 automatically be transferred to and absorbed by the VMMC as herein created. The 8 incumbent Medical Director shall continue to serve as such for a period of three (3) 9 years or until his successor shall have been appointed by the President of the 10 Philippines.

SECTION 13. Assistance from Government Offices. - The VMMC may call upon any departments, bureau, office, agency, or instrumentality of the government, including GOCCs, for such assistance as it may need in the pursuit of its purposes and objectives. All individuals, entities and institutions are hereby enjoined to render full assistance and cooperation to VMMC in the accomplishment of its objectives and activities.

SECTION 14. Property of Medical Center. - All existing assets of the VMMC 17 including, but not limited to, the parcel of land belonging to the government situated in 18 the district, Quezon City and more particularly described in the Bureau of Lands as Lot 19 20 R.P.-3-B-4-A, BSD-10352, all its buildings and other properties shall remain with the 21 VMMC as a corporate entity, including those that may hereafter be given, donated, 22 acquired, transferred or conveyed to the Medical Center or its branches and 23 instrumentalities by any foreign government, as well as those given by trust, 24 foundations, corporations, or persons whether citizen or not. The absolute ownership of 25 the Medical Center over these landholdings including those covered by original and 26 transfer certificates of title in the name of the VMMC is hereby confirmed. Where the 27 issuance of proper certificates of title is still pending for those landholdings the proper 28 government office shall expedite issuance thereof within six (6) months from the date of 29 effectivity of this Act; Provided, That all registration requirements necessary for the 30 issuance of the said titles have been submitted and complied with.

31 SECTION 15. Land Grants and other Real Properties. - The use of properties 32 and proceeds of such properties shall be governed by the following:

(a) The State shall support the VMMC in the sum or lump sum amount,
through the general appropriations and other financial benefits, and in
kind, through land grants and donations and use of other real properties.
To carry out the intent of these grants, income derived from the
development of all land grants and real properties shall be used to further

the ends of the hospital, as may be decided by the Board of Trustees in furtherance of the declared hospital objectives under this Act;

 (b) Such parcels of land ceded by law, decree or presidential issuance to the hospital are hereby declared to be reserved for the purposes intended;

(c) The Board of Trustees shall plan, design and approve and/or cause the implementation of contracts, mechanisms and financial instruments, such as joint ventures, long term leases, fully owned subsidiaries and securitization to give the hospital the flexibility to generate revenues and other resources from land grants and other properties; Provided, That

10such mechanism and arrangements shall sustain and protect the11environment in accordance with law, and be exclusive of the medical core12zone of the hospital; Provided, Finally, That such mechanism and13arrangements shall not conflict with the medical or health services and14academic mission of the hospital; and

15(d)Any plan to generate revenues and other sources from land grants and16other real properties entrusted to the hospital shall be consistent with the17hospital mission and orientation as a vehicle to extend health services to18veterans and their dependents.

19 SECTION 16. Safeguards on Asset Disposition. - The preservation of the value 20 of the assets of the hospital shall be of primordial consideration. The exclusive core 21 zone of the VMMC as defined in Section 14 shall not be sold, transferred, ceded, 22 conveyed, assigned and encumbered.

SECTION 17. Annual Report. - The VMMC shall render to the President of the
 Philippines an annual report of its activities and recommendations.

SECTION 18. Effect of Dissolution. - If, for any reason, the VMMC is dissolved, its
 property remaining at the time of such dissolution shall revert to the Republic of the
 Philippines for disposition in accordance with law.

SECTION 19. Implementing Rules. - The implementing rules and regulations shall
 be formulated within ninety (90) days from the approval of this Act.

30 SECTION 20. Separability Clause. - If any provision of this Act is declared 31 unconstitutional, all the other provisions not affected shall remain in force and effect.

32 **SECTION 21. Repealing Clause**- All laws, decrees, executive orders, rules and 33 regulations or other issuances or parts thereof contrary to or inconsistent with the 34 provisions of this Act are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

35 **SECTION 22. Effectivity Clause.** - This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after 36 its complete publication in the Official Gazette or in at least two (2) newspapers of 37 general circulation.
