AN ACT

TO ESTABLISH THE NATIONAL RESEARCH, DEVELOPMENT AND EXTENSION CENTER FOR PINEAPPLE, AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS THEREFOR, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The Philippines is among the top producers of pineapple fruit in the world. In 2004, fresh pineapples were mainly exported to Japan and South Korea while canned pineapples were mainly exported to USA (excluding Hawaii and Alaska). In 2004, 80 countries produced 13,705,091 of which Thailand was the leading producer with 15% share of the world's output, Philippines with 13% share.

Pineapple is extensively cultivated in the country. Large plantations on Mindanao mainly export the fruits while those on Luzon and in the Visayas supply the domestic markets. A total of 48,238 ha were planted to pineapple, producing 1.7M tonnes (2004). Major producing regions are Northern Mindanao, SOCCSKSARGEN (Southern Cotabato, Cotabato Province, Sultan Kudarat, Sarangani, General Santos City), Bicol and Calabarzon (Cavite, Laguna, Batangas, Rizal, and Quezon).

Pineapple market is worldwide and highly competitive. Pineapple is the third most important tropical fruit next to banana and mango. However, in many countries, resources for pineapple research have notably declined in these most recent years possibly due to poorer earnings. Moreover, there is a gap between public research and private needs for pineapple development.

The legislation envisions the creation of a National Research, Development and Extension Center for Pineapple to bridge this gap, in as far as the Philippine pineapple industry is concerned. This center is tasked to undertake comprehensive research on the advancement of pineapple cultivation and post-harvest handling. Its powers and functions shall be in line with the research, development and extension programs of concerned government agencies which include the Department of Agriculture - Bureau of Agricultural Research (DA-BAR), Department of Science and Technology (DOST), Department of Trade and Industry (DTI), National Economic and Development Authority (NEDA) and Central Mindanao University.

In view of the foregoing, the approval of this bill is earnestly sought.

AN ACT

TO ESTABLISH THE NATIONAL RESEARCH, DEVELOPMENT AND EXTENSION CENTER FOR PINEAPPLE, AUTHORIZING THE APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS THEREFOR, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. National Research, Development and Extension Center for Pineapple - The National Research, Development and Extension Center for Pineapple (hereinafter referred to as NRDECP), which shall be based in the Central Mindanao University in Musuan, Bukidnon, is hereby established.

SEC. 2. General Powers and Functions of the Center. - The Center shall have the following general powers and functions in line with the research, development and extension programs of the Department of Agriculture - Bureau of Agricultural Research (DA-BAR), Department of Science and Technology (DOST), Department of Trade and Industry (DTI), National Economic and Development Authority (NEDA) and Central Mindanao University:

a) to educate and train all stakeholders of the pineapple industry;

b) to undertake basic and strategic research for developing technologies to enhance productivity and utilization of pineapple;

c) to explore various approaches such as, but not limited to hybridization, utilization of clonal variability and induced mutation in suckers, in vitro culture and hybrid seeds, in developing new varieties in pineapple;

d) to provide leadership and coordinate the network research for generating location varieties, technology and for solving specific constraints of pineapple production;

e) to standardize the management practices and to provide farm advisory services in all aspects of pineapple production; and

All other officers and employees of the Center shall be appointed by the Executive Director consistent with the provisions of the Civil Service laws, rules and regulations.

SEC. 5. *Advisory Board.* - The plans and programs of the Center shall be reviewed annually by the Advisory Board which shall be composed of:

a) The Secretary of the Department of Agriculture as Chairman;

b) The University President of the Central Mindanao University as Vice Chairman;

c) The Secretary of the Department of Trade and Industry as member;

d) One (1) representative from a non-governmental organization (NGO) working on pineapple production, research and development and processing;

e) One (1) representative from the group of pineapple traders;

f) One (1) representative from the group of pineapple processors; and

g) One (1) representative from the group of pineapple growers.

Automatic Appropriations under the General Appropriations Act.

SEC. 6. Quorum. - The presence of at least five (5) members at the time of the meeting shall constitute the quorum. Provided, however, that the Chairman, in his absence, the Vice Chairman shall preside.

SEC. 7. Authorization and Exemption. - The Center is hereby authorized to plan, construct, develop, improve, acquire, or lease buildings, farms, fields and other facilities, to purchase machineries, equipment, materials and supplies locally or abroad as may be necessary to carry out its functions and objectives. Moreover, the Center shall enjoy exemption from taxes and other duties in the importation of such machineries, development and extension programs, subject to the provisions of Section 105(s) of the Tariff and Customs Code, Section 103(f) of the National Internal Revenue Code and to the provisions on

SEC. 8. Location of the Center. - The main offices, experimental area and nursery of the Center shall be located at the Central Mindanao University in Musuan, Bukidnon. The Center may hereafter establish similar facilities in its other service areas in order to promote the development of the pineapple industry in the country.

SEC. 9. Appropriations. - To carry out the provisions of this Act, the amount of Two million pesos (P2,000,000.00) is hereby appropriated from the funds of the National Treasury. Thereafter, such sums as may be necessary to maintain the operations of the Board shall be included in the General Appropriations Act.

1 2 3	SEC. 10. Revolving Funds Any and all savings and income of the Center shall constitute a revolving fund which shall not be reverted to the General Fund and which shall be used by the Center in the furtherance of its goals and objectives.
4 5 6 7	SEC. 11. Implementing Rules and Regulations The Advisory Board shall jointly promulgate rules and regulations to implement the provisions of this Act.

SEC. 12. Repealing Clause. - All laws, decrees, orders, rules and regulations inconsistent with or contrary to the provisions of this Act are hereby amended or repealed accordingly.

SEC. 13. *Effectivity Clause.* - This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days following its complete publication in the National Gazette or in at least two (2) newspapers of general circulation, whichever comes earlier.
