BE KNOWN AS "PUP- SAN JUAN CAMPUS"
APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREOF AND FOR
OTHER PURPOSES

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- 1 SECTION 1. This Act shall be known as the "PUP- San
- 2 Juan Campus Act".
- 3 SEC. 2. It is hereby declared by the State to provide
- 4 accessible, quality and affordable education to all PUP
- 5 System, since it was created proves the same.
- 6 SEC. 3. The PUP- San Juan Campus shall offer
- 7 graduate, undergraduate and short-term technical courses

- within the areas of specialization and according to its capabilities, as the Board of Regents may deem necessary to carry out its objectives, particular in order to meet the needs of the province and the region. The University Campus is also mandated to undertake research and extension services, and provides progressive leadership in these areas, includes the offering of post graduate degrees
- 9 SEC. 4. The University shall have the general powers
 10 of a corporation set forth in the Corporation Law. The
 11 administration of the University and the exercise of its
 12 powers shall be vested exclusively in the Board of Regents
 13 of the PUP.

- SEC. 5. The University Campus shall provide a scholarship program and other affirmative action programs to assist poor but deserving students to qualify for admission to the University.
- No student shall be denied admission to the
 University Campus by reason of sex, religion, cultural or
 community affiliation or ethnic origin.

SEC. 6. The University Campus shall enjoy academic 1 2 freedom. University Campus faculties, staff and students 3 religious belief shall be respected at all times. SEC. 7. On or before the fifteenth of the second month 4 5 after the opening of the regular class each year, the Board shall file with both Houses of Congress a detailed report on 6 7 the progress, conditions and needs of the PUP- San Juan 8 Campus. SEC. 8. The amount necessary to carry out the 9 10 provisions of this Act shall be charged against the current year's appropriations of the PUP. Thereafter, such sums as 11 12 may be necessary for the continued operation and maintenance of the PUP shall be included in the annual 13 14 General Appropriations Act. 15 SEC. 9. In coordination with the PUP, within a period of one hundred twenty (120) days after the approval of this 16 17 Act, the PUP- San Juan Campus shall accomplish the 18 following: 19 (a) Submit a five (5) year development plan, including

its corresponding program budget, to the Commission on

- 1 Higher Education (CHED), for appropriate
- 2 recommendation to the Department of Budget and
- 3 Management;
- 4 (b) Undergo a management audit in cooperation with
- 5 the CHED;
- 6 (c) Accordingly set up its organizational,
- 7 administrative as well as academic, structure, including
- 8 the appointment/designation of University Campus key
- 9 officials.
- 10 SEC. 10. The provisions of Republic Act No. 8292,
- 11 otherwise known as the "Higher Education Modernization
- 12 Act of 1997" shall form an integral part of this Act and
- 13 together shall serve as the governing charter of the
- 14 University.
- 15 SEC. 11. All other powers, functions, privileges,
- 16 responsibilities and limitations to state universities and/or
- 17 its official under existing laws shall be deemed granted to
- 18 or imposed upon the University and/or its officials
- 19 whenever appropriate.

- 1 SEC. 12. All laws, presidential decrees, executive
- 2 orders, rules and regulations contrary to or inconsistent
- 3 with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed,
- 4 amended or modified accordingly.
- SEC. 13. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.Approved,
