SENATE BILL NO. 900

AN ACT

PROVIDING TELECOMMUNICATIONS SYSTEMS ACCESSIBILITY TO THE HEARING-IMPAIRED AND SPEECH-IMPAIRED

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The State recognizes the importance of the disabled sector. Pursuant to this mandate, it established the National Commission for Disabled Persons to ensure that the rights of the handicapped are protected, and that all programs and services are universal and accessible to all segments of society.

Although modern technology has created devices to cater to the special needs of handicapped persons, they still need assistance with communication facilities for the hearing-impaired and speech-impaired.

This proposed measure seeks to make the national telecommunication system available to the hearing-impaired and speech-impaired.

The early passage of this proposed measure is highly recommended.

PROVIDING TELECOMMUNICATIONS SYSTEMS ACCESSIBILITY TO THE HEARING-IMPAIRED AND SPEECH-IMPAIRED

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1	SECTION 1. Short Title This Act shall be known as the			
2	"Telecommunications Accessibility Enhancement Act".

5	SEC. 2. Declaration of Policy It is hereby declared as a policy of the State			
6	to provide handicapped persons protection and assistance to hasten their integration			
7	into the mainstream of society.

10	SEC. 3. Definition For the purpose of this Act, the following terms shall			
11	have the corresponding definitions:

13	(1) "TDD" or Telecommunications Devices for the Deaf is a machine which			
14	employs graphic communications in the transmission of coded signals			
15	through the nationwide telecommunications system;

17	(2) "Secretary" refers to the Secretary of Transportation and

21	SEC. 4. National Telecommunications Systems Requirements. –

SEC. 8. Effectivity. - This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
publication in at least two (2) newspapers of general circulation.
