EXPANDING THE POWERS AND FUNCTIONS OF THE MOVIE AND TELEVISION REVIEW AND CLASSIFICATION BOARD TO PROVIDE FOR THE REGULATION OF VIDEO GAMES AND ()UTDOOR MEDIA, ' AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE PRESIDENTIAL DECREE NO. 1986

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The Movie and Television Review and Classification Board (MTRCB), established by Presidential Decree No. 1986 in 1985, serves an important role in safeguarding our children from violent, obscene, and otherwise harmful material that may endanger their safety and wellbeing. The ratings published by the MTRCB educate parents about the subject matter discussed and portrayed in these media, empowering them to make informed decisions about the kind of media to which they wish to expose their children. This is certainly a worthy undertaking that has been duly accomplished by the MTRCB for almost 30 years now.

However, the mandate of this Board, delineated well before the proliferation of affordable and accessible computer technology, does not cover another potent type of visual media - video games. Since the late 19908 many countries have expanded the functions and powers of their respective movie and television regulatory bodies to include the review and classification of video games, owing to the increasingly dominant position of video games in visual entertainment worldwide. These regulatory bodies have also focused on ensuring that video games with mature themes do not fall into the hands of those too young to properly process the graphic and violent scenes they are controlling on the screen.

According to the 2009 Nielsen Global Online Consumer Survey, Filipinos are the top consumers of video games in the entire world. In order to ensure the safety and wellbeing of our children, working hand-in-hand with the responsible and nurturing parents and guardians of our great Nation, it is paramount that we upgrade the bureaucracy in the face of new technologies and changing times. Thus, this legislation aims to reorganize the MTRCB into a more versatile body up-to-date with the needs of contemporary Philippine society.

In addition to video games, this legislation also gives MTRCB regulatory powers over the content of outdoor media. Real:stically, it is virtually impossible to restrict access of minors to outdoor media since by definition they are prominently displayed in public spaces. Thus, in order to further protect the safety and well-being of our children we must take steps to ensure that obscene outdoor media will be prohibited as necessary. Since the functions of MTRCB already include the review of certain publicity materials, it is logical to delegate the review of outdoor media to this body as well.

Support for the passage and approval of this legislation is earnestly sought.

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EXPANDING THE POWERS AND FUNCTIONS OF THE MOVIE AND TELEVISION REVIEW AND CLASSIFICATION BOARD TO PROVIDE FOR THE REGULATION OF VIDEO GAMES AND OUTDOOR MEDIA, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE PRESIDENTIAL DECREE NO. 1986

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Short Title. - This Act shall be known as the "Video Game
 and Outdoor Media Regulation Act".

3 SEC. 2. Paragraphs 1 and 2 of Section 2 regarding Composition,
 4 Qualifications, and Benefits are hereby amended to read as follows:

6 The Board shall be composed of a Chairman, a Vice-Chairman 7 and [thirty (30) members] THIRTY-FIVE (35) MEMBERS, who 8 shall all be appointed by the President of the Philippines. The 9 Chairman, the Vice-Chairman, and the members of the Board, shall hold office for a term of one (1) year, unless sooner 10 11 removed by the President for any cause; Provided, That they 12 shall be eligible for re-appointment after the expiration of their 13 term. If the Chairman, or the Vice-Chairman or any member of 14 the Board fails to complete his term, any person appointed to

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fill the vacancy shall serve only for the unexpired portion of the term of the Board member whom he succeeds.

3 No person shall be appointed to the Board, unless he is a 4 natural-born citizen of the Philippines, not less than twenty-one 5 (21) years of age, and of good moral character and standing in the 6 community; Provided, That in the selection of the members 7 of the Board due consideration shall be given to such 8 qualifications as would produce a multi-sectoral combination of 9 the various of motion picture. expertise in areas VIDEO 10 GAMES, OUTDOOR MEDIA, and television; Provided, further, 11 That at least five (5) members of the BOARD shall be members 12 of the Philippine Bar; Provided, *finally FURTHER*, That at 13 least fifteen (15) members of the Board may come from the 14 movie and television industry to be nominated by legitimate 15 associations representing the various sectors of said industry, 16 PROVIDED, FINALLY, THAT AT LEAST FIVE (5) MEMBERS 17 OF THE BOARD MAY COME FROM VIDEO GAME AND 18 OUTDOOR MEDIA **INDUSTRIES** TO BE NOMINATED BY 19 LEGITIMATE ASSOCIATIONS REPRESENTING THE VARIOUS 20 SECTORS OF SAID INDUSTRY.

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22SEC. 3. Section 3 regarding Powersand Functions is hereby23amended to read as follows:

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27 b) To screen, review and examine all motion pictures, VIDEO 28 GAMES, AND OUTDOOR MEDIA as herein defined, television, 29 including programs, publicity materia's such as 30 advertisements, trailers and stills. whether such motion 31 materials be for theatrical or pictures and publicity non-32 theatrical distribution, for television broadcast or for general 33 viewing, imported or produced in the Philippines, and in the 34 latter case, whether they be for local viewing or for export;

22 THE PACKAGING OF ANY VIDEO GAME AND ANY PRINTED OR 23 DIGITAL PUBLICITY MATERIAL, WHETHER LOCALLY-24 PRODUCED OR IMPORTED, THAT IS SOLD ANIJ/OR DISTRIBUTED · 25 IN THE PHILIPPINES MUST DISPLAY ITS RATING AS ASSIGNED 26 BY THE BOARD IN AN EASILY-VIEWABLE, LEGIBLE MANNER ON 27 THE FRONT SIDE IN THE STYLE AND MANNER PRESCRIBED BY THE BOARD. DIGITAL COPIES OF GAMES MUST DISPLAY THE 28 29 RATING LABEL ON THE MENU SCREEN.

7 APPLY TO CASES IN WHICH VIDEO GAMES OR OUTDOOR MEDIA
8 ARE DEEMED BY THE BOARD, AFTER EXAMINATION AND REVIEW,
9 TO BE UNFIT FOR CONSUMPTION IN THE PHILIPPINES.

11 SEC. 10. *Implementing Rules and Regulations.* - Within (60) days 12 from the effectivity of this Act, the Board shall promulgate the implementing 13 rules and regulations as may be necessary to ensure the efficient and effective 14 implementation of this Act.

15 SEC. 11. *Separability Clause.* - Should any part of this Act be declared 16 unconstitutional, the rest of the provisions of this Act shall continue to be in 17 effect and subsisting.

18 SEC. 12. *Amendatory Clause.* - The pertinent provisions of P.D. No. 19 1986, in so far as they are inconsistent herewith, are hereby expressly 20 amended or modified accordingly.

SEC. 13. *Repealing Clause.* - The provisions of other laws, decrees,
executive orders, rules and regulations inconsistent with this Act are hereby
repealed, amended, or modified accordingly.

24 SEC. 14. *Effectivity Clause.* - This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days 25 after its publication in the *Official Gazette* and/or in at least two (2) national 26 newspapers in general circulation.
