SEVENTEENTH CONGRESS FIRST REGULAR SESSION

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CALL TO ORDER

At 3:14 p.m., the Senate President, Hon. Aquilino "Koko" Pimentel III, called the session to order.

With the concurrence of Senator Legarda, the principal author, and as manifested by Senator Sotto, Senator Pacquiao was made coauthor of Senate Bill No. 404 (declaring July 27 of Every Year A Special Nonworking Holiday in Observance of the Founding Anniversary of the Iglesia ni Cristo).

CHANGES IN COMMITTEE MEMBERSHIPS

Upon motion of Senator Sotto, there being no objection, Senator Gatchalian was elected member of the Committee on Climate Change in lieu of Senator Honasan; Senator Honasan, on the other hand, was elected member of the Committee on Urban

Urban Planning, Housing and Resettlement in lieu of Senator Gatchalian, and member of the Committee on Agrarian Reform in lieu of Senator Zubiri.

Upon motion of Senator Sotto, there being no objection, the Chair declared the session adjourned until three o'clock in the afternoon of the following day.
