RECOGNIZING AND COMMENDING JOSEPHINE MEDINA FOR
WINNING BRONZE MEDAL IN THE 2016 PARALYMPIC
GAMES IN RIO DE JANEIRO, BRAZIL

WHEREAS, Josephine Medina is one of the five athletes representing the Philippines in the ongoing Paralympic Games in Rio De Janeiro, Brazil;


WHEREAS, Medina beat Julianne Wolf of Germany in the women's singles Class 8 in table tennis that earned her the bronze medal;

WHEREAS, Medina's victory marks the Philippines first medal in this year's iteration and ending the 16-year medal drought;

WHEREAS, the UPeepz displayed brilliance and excellence in the field of hip hop dancing by garnering the title from one of the most competitive dance events in the world;
