RESOLUTION

CONGRATULATING AND COMMENDING JANELLE MAE FRAYNA FOR BEING GRANTED THE TITLE OF CHESS GRANDMASTER AFTER AN OUTSTANDING PERFORMANCE IN THE 42ND WORLD CHESS OLYMPIAD THAT WAS HELD ON SEPTEMBER 1 TO 14, 2016 AT BAKU, AZERBAIJAN

WHEREAS, the Philippine Senate has in several occasions paid tribute to exemplary Filipinos for their contribution in bringing pride and honor to the country by winning international competitions;

WHEREAS, the 20 year old Janelle Mae Frayna was awarded the title of Grandmaster for her outstanding performance in the 42nd World Chess Olympiad that was held on September 1 to 14, 2016 at Azerbaijan⁴;

WHEREAS, Janelle Mae Frayna won the award by finishing with a rating of 2281 at the end of the competition by posting four wins, four draws, and one loss in nine games⁵;
