**AN ACT
CONVERTING THE MARAYMARAY BARANGAY ROAD IN THE
MUNICIPALITY OF DON CARLOS, PROVINCE OF BUKIDNON INTO A
NATIONAL ROAD, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR**

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This bill seeks to convert the Maraymaray Barangay Road in the municipality of Don Carlos in the Province of Bukidnon into a national road.

The Maraymaray Barangay Road is one of the key access roads in the construction of the proposed Bukidnon Airport. It will be utilized by tourists and locals in the transfer of various equipment and goods to and from the province. Its improvement and maintenance will greatly contribute to commerce and tourism in the area, by facilitating greater and smoother access to the municipalities it connects.

In view of the foregoing, the swift passage of this bill is earnestly sought.

AN ACT
CONVERTING THE MARAYMARAY BARANGAY ROAD IN THE
MUNICIPALITY OF DON CARLOS, PROVINCE OF BUKIDNON INTO A
NATIONAL ROAD, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the
Philippines in Congress assembled:*

SECTION 1. The Maraymaray Barangay road in the municipality of Don Carlos in
the Province of Bukidnon is hereby converted into a national road.

SEC. 2. The Secretary of the Department of Public Works and Highways shall
include in the Department's program the improvement, maintenance and repair
of the said road, the funding of which shall be included in the annual General
Appropriations Act.

SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect fifteen days after its publication in the Official
Gazette and in at least two (2) newspaper of general circulation.
