AN ACT EXPANDING THE COVERAGE OF EXEMPTIONS FROM REVEALING THE SOURCE OF PUBLISHED NEWS **INFORMATION** OR OBTAINED CONFIDENCE BY INCLUDING JOURNALISTS FROM BROADCAST. NEWS AGENCIES INTERNET PUBLICATIONS, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE SECTION 1 OF REPUBLIC ACT NO. 53, AS AMENDED BY REPUBLIC ACT NO. 1477

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of Republic Act No. 53,
- 2 otherwise known as "An Act to Exempt the Publisher,
- 3 Editor or Reporter of any Publication from Revealing the
- 4 Source of Published News or Information Obtained in
- 5 Confidence", as amended by Republic Act No. 1477, is
- 6 hereby further amended, to read as follows:

1	"SECTION 1. Without prejudice to his/her
2	liability under the civil and criminal laws, [the]
3	ANY publisher, OWNER, [editor, columnist] or
4	duly RECOGNIZED OR accredited
5	JOURNALIST, WRITER, reporter, [of any
6	newspaper, magazine or periodical of general
7	circulation] CONTRIBUTOR, OPINION
8	WRITER, EDITOR, COLUMNIST,
9	MANAGER, MEDIA PRACTITIONER
10	INVOLVED IN THE WRITING, EDITING,
11	PRODUCTION, AND DISSEMINATION OF
12	NEWS FOR MASS CIRCULATION, OF ANY
13	PRINT, BROADCAST, WIRE SERVICE
14	ORGANIZATION, OR ELECTRONIC MASS
15	MEDIA, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED
16	TO, THE INTERNET, AND CABLE TV AND
17	ITS VARIANTS, cannot be compelled to reveal
18	the source of any news[-] ITEM, report or
19	information appearing [in] OR BEING
20	REPORTED OR DISSEMINATED THROUGH

1	said [publication] MEDIA, which was related in
2	confidence to [such publisher, editor or
3	reporter] THE ABOVEMENTIONED MEDIA
4	PRACTITIONERS unless the court or [a] THE
5	House OF REPRESENTATIVES OR THE
6	SENATE or ANY committee of Congress finds
7	that such revelation is demanded by the
8	security of the State."
9	SEC. 2. Repealing Clause All laws, decrees,
10	executive orders, rules or regulations or parts thereof
11	inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby
12	repealed or modified.
13	SEC. 3. Effectivity This Act shall take effect
14	fifteen (15) days after its complete publication in at least
15	two (2) newspapers of general circulation.
