Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1	SECTION 1. Creation of Barangay South Signal Village South		
2	Signal Village Proper in Barangay Signal Village, City of Taguig, Metro		
3	Manila is hereby separated from Barangay Signal Village and constituted into		
4	a distinct and independent barangay to be known as Barangay South Signal		
5	Village.		
6	SEC. 2. Territorial Boundaries The territorial boundaries of		
7	Barangay South Signal Village shall consist of permanent natural boundaries		
8	identified as follows:		
9	"Bounded on the North by Luzon Avenue, Espino Street, Callejon		
10	Balleser Street and Calle Cabasaan;		
11	On the South and Southwest by Maharlika Village, a creek, Barangay		
12	Upper Bicutan (Proclamation No. 172) Psd-013-002680;		
13	On the East by NAPOCOR High Tension Line; and		
14	On the West by F.T.I. Compound,"		

- SEC. 3. Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite. The plebiscite 1 2 conducted and supervised by the Commission on Elections (COMELEC) in Barangay Signal Village pursuant to City Ordinance No. 60, Series of 2008 of 3 4 the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Taguig, which ratified the creation 5 of Barangay South Signal Village as proclaimed by the City Board of Canvassers on December 28, 2008, shall serve as substantial compliance with 6 7 the plebiscite requirement under Section 10 of Republic Act No. 7160, as 8 amended, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991".
- SEC. 4. Incumbent Barangay Officials. The incumbent barangay officials of Barangay South Signal Village, City of Taguig shall continue to hold office until such time that their successors have been duly elected and qualified.
 - SEC. 5. Public Infrastructure and Facilities. All public infrastructure and facilities for public use existing therein at the time of the approval of this Act are hereby transferred without cost or compensation to and shall be administered by the new barangay.
- SEC. 6. Internal Revenue Allotment Shares. Barangay South Signal Village shall be entitled to Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) shares pursuant to Section 285 of Republic Act No. 7160, as amended, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991".
 - SEC. 7. Separability Clause. If, for any reason, any part or provision of this Act is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.
- SEC. 8. Effectivity. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official Gazette or in any newspaper of general circulation.
