Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1	SECTION 1. Creation of Barangay Central Signal Village The				
2	Central Signal Village Proper in Barangay Signal Village, City of Taguig,				
3	Metro Manila is hereby separated from Barangay Signal Village and				
4	constituted into a distinct and independent barangay to be known as Barangay				
5	Central Signal Village.				
6	SEC. 2. Territorial Boundaries The territorial boundaries of				
7	Barangay Central Signal Village shall consist of permanent natural boundaries				
8	identified as follows:				
9	"Bounded on the North by Sampaloc Street and M.R.T. Avenue				
10	(formerly Cuasay Street);				
H	On the South by Governor Rodriguez Avenue, Luzon Avenue, Espino				
12	Street, Callejon Balleser Street and Calle Cabasaan;				
13	On the East by NAPOCOR High Tension Power Line;				
14	On the Northwest by Veterans Compound; and				
15	On the Southwest by F.T.I. Compound."				
16	SEC. 3. Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite The plebiscite				
17	conducted and supervised by the Commission on Elections (COMELEC) in				

- 1 Barangay Signal Village pursuant to City Ordinance No. 61, Series of 2008 of
- 2 the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Taguig, which ratified the creation
- 3 of Barangay Central Signal Village as proclaimed by the City Board of
- 4 Canvassers on December 28, 2008, shall serve as substantial compliance with
- 5 the plebiscite requirement under Section 10 of Republic Act No. 7160, as
- 6 amended, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991".
- 7 SEC. 4. Incumbent Barangay Officials. The incumbent barangay
- 8 officials of Barangay Central Signal Village, City of Taguig shall continue to
- 9 hold office until such time that their successors have been duly elected and
- 10 qualified.
- 11 SEC. 5. Public Infrastructure and Facilities. All public
- 12 infrastructure and facilities for public use existing therein at the time of the
- 13 approval of this Act are hereby transferred without cost or compensation to
- and shall be administered by the new barangay.
- 15 SEC. 6. Internal Revenue Allotment Shares. Barangay Central
- 16 Signal Village shall be entitled to Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) shares
- 17 pursuant to Section 285 of Republic Act No. 7160, as amended, otherwise
- 18 known as the "Local Government Code of 1991".
- 19 SEC. 7. Separability Clause. If, for any reason, any part or
- 20 provision of this Act is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other parts or
- 21 provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full
- 22 force and effect.
- 23 SEC. 8. Effectivity. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
- 24 its publication in the Official Gazette or in any newspaper of general
- 25 circulation.
