





AN ACT CREATING A BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY
NORTH DAANG HARI IN THE CITY OF TAGUIG, METRO
MANILA

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. *Creation of Barangay North Daang Hari.* – The North
2 Daang Hari Proper in Barangay Bagong Tanyag, City of Taguig, Metro
3 Manila is hereby separated from Barangay Bagong Tanyag and constituted
4 into a distinct and independent barangay to be known as Barangay North
5 Daang Hari.

6 SEC. 2. *Territorial Boundaries.* – The territorial boundaries of
7 Barangay North Daang Hari shall consist of permanent natural boundaries
8 identified as follows:

9 “Bounded on the North by General Santos Avenue;
10 On the East by Case 14 590-D, Taguig Cadastral Mapping (Barangay
11 Bagumbayan), P.U.P. Compound, Sta. Maria Industrial Subdivision and the
12 Manila Railroad Company (Railroad Tract);
13 On the South by Mañalac Avenue; and
14 On the West by Parañaque Cadastre.”

15 SEC. 3. *Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite.* – The plebiscite
16 conducted and supervised by the Commission on Elections (COMELEC) in
17 Barangay Bagong Tanyag pursuant to City Ordinance No. 27, Series of 2008

1 of the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Taguig, which ratified the
2 creation of Barangay North Daang Hari as proclaimed by the City Board of
3 Canvassers on December 28, 2008, shall serve as substantial compliance with
4 the plebiscite requirement under Section 10 of Republic Act No. 7160, as
5 amended, otherwise known as the "Local Government Code of 1991".

6 SEC. 4. *Incumbent Barangay Officials.* – The incumbent barangay
7 officials of Barangay North Daang Hari, City of Taguig shall continue to hold
8 office until such time that their successors have been duly elected and
9 qualified.

10 SEC. 5. *Public Infrastructure and Facilities.* – All public
11 infrastructure and facilities for public use existing therein at the time of the
12 approval of this Act are hereby transferred without cost or compensation to
13 and shall be administered by the new barangay.

14 SEC. 6. *Internal Revenue Allotment Shares.* – Barangay North
15 Daang Hari shall be entitled to Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) shares
16 pursuant to Section 285 of Republic Act No. 7160, as amended, otherwise
17 known as the "Local Government Code of 1991".

18 SEC. 7. *Separability Clause.* – If, for any reason, any part or
19 provision of this Act is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other parts or
20 provisions which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and
21 effect.

22 SEC. 8. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
23 its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in any newspaper of general
24 circulation.
