Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- SECTION 1. June 18 of every year is hereby declared a special nonworking holiday in the Province of Ifugao, in commemoration of its founding anniversary, to be known as the "Ifugao Foundation Day".
- SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
