AN ACT DECLARING FEBRUARY 3 OF EVERY YEAR A SPECIAL
[NON]WORKING HOLIDAY IN THE CITY OF BIÑAN, PROVINCE
OF LAGUNA, TO BE KNOWN AS "BIÑAN LIBERATION DAY"

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. February 3 of every year is hereby declared a special
2 [non]working holiday in the City of Biñan, Province of Laguna, in
3 commemoration of the liberation of the town of Biñan, now the City of Biñan,
4 from the Japanese Imperial Forces, to be known as "Biñan Liberation Day".
5 UPON PROCLAMATION OF THE PRESIDENT FEBRUARY 3 OF
6 EVERY YEAR SHALL BE A SPECIAL NONWORKING HOLIDAY
7 IN THE CITY OF BIÑAN, PROVINCE OF LAGUNA.

8 SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication
9 in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
