MR. PRESIDENT:

The Committees on Local Government; and Electoral and People's Participation, to
which was referred House Bill No. **4934**, introduced by Representative Ann K. Hofer
entitled:

**"AN ACT CREATING A BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY SAN ISIDRO IN THE
MUNICIPALITY OF TITAY, PROVINCE OF ZAMBOANGA SIBUGAY"**

have considered the same and have the honor to report it back to the Senate with the
recommendation that it be approved with the following amendments:

1. On page 1, line 4, before Sec. 2 (Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite), insert a
new section to read as follows:

"SEC. 2. TERRITORIAL BOUNDARIES. – THE TERRITORIAL BOUNDARIES OF BARANGAY
SAN ISIDRO SHALL BE IDENTIFIED AS FOLLOWS:

Bounded on the North West along line 1-2 by Barangay San Antonio;

On the North East along lines 2-3-4 by Barangay San Antonio; along line 4-5-6 by Municipality of Ipil vs Titay, Zamboanga Sibugay; along lines 6-7 by Municipality of Ipil, Zamboanga Sibugay;

On the South East along lines 7-8-9-10 by Municipality of Ipil, Zamboanga Sibugay;

On the South West along lines 10-11-12 by Municipality of RT Lim, Zamboanga Sibugay;

On the West along line 12-1 to the point of beginning by Barangay San Antonio vs. Dalisay, all of Titay Municipality.

Beginning at a point marked Corner "1"=BLLM #1, Cad 1130-D, Titay Cadastre:

AN ACT CREATING A BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY
SAN ISIDRO IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TITAY, PROVINCE OF
ZAMBOANGA SIBUGAY

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. *Creation of Barangay San Isidro.* – There is hereby
2 created a barangay to be known as Barangay San Isidro in the Municipality of
3 Titay, Province of Zamboanga Sibugay.”

4 SEC. 2. *Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite.* – The plebiscite
5 conducted and supervised by the Commission on Elections (COMELEC)
6 pursuant to Provincial Ordinance No. 2002-122 dated August 7, 2002 of the
7 Sangguniang Panlalawigan of the Province of Zamboanga Sibugay, which
8 ratified the creation of Barangay San Isidro as proclaimed by the Plebiscite
9 Board of Canvassers on April 16, 2005, shall serve as substantial compliance
10 with the plebiscite requirement under Section 10 of Republic Act No. 7160, as
11 amended, otherwise known as the “Local Government Code of 1991”.

12 SEC. 3. *Incumbent Barangay Officials.* – The incumbent barangay
13 officials of Barangay San Isidro shall continue to hold office until such time
14 that their successors have been duly elected and qualified.

1 SEC. 4. *Public Infrastructure and Facilities.* – All public
2 infrastructure and facilities for public use existing therein at the time of the
3 approval of this Act are hereby transferred without cost or compensation to
4 and shall be administered by the new barangay.

5 SEC. 5. *Internal Revenue Allotment Shares.* – Barangay San Isidro
6 shall be entitled to Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) shares pursuant to
7 Section 285 of Republic Act No. 7160, as amended, otherwise known as the
8 “Local Government Code of 1991”.

9 SEC. 6. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
10 its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
