AN ACT DECLARING SEPTEMBER 3 OF EVERY YEAR A SPECIAL
[NON]WORKING PUBLIC HOLIDAY [IN THE CITY OF
BAGUIO, PROVINCE OF BENGUET] THROUGHOUT THE
COUNTRY, IN COMMEMORATION OF THE SURRENDER OF
THE JAPANESE MILITARY FORCES LED BY GENERAL
TOMOYUKI YAMASHITA IN BAGUIO CITY

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. September 3 of every year is hereby declared a special
2 [non]working PUBLIC holiday [in the City of Baguio, Province of Benguet]
3 THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY, in commemoration of the surrender of
4 the Japanese military forces led by General Tomoyuki Yamashita at the
5 American High Commissioner's Residence in Camp John Hay, Baguio City.

6 SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
7 publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
