AN ACT DECLARING MARCH 2 OF EVERY YEAR A SPECIAL [NON]WORKING HOLIDAY IN THE PROVINCE OF LA UNION IN COMMEMORATION OF ITS FOUNDING ANNIVERSARY, TO BE KNOWN AS "LA UNION DAY"

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. March 2 of every year is hereby declared a special [non]working holiday in the Province of La Union in commemoration of its founding anniversary, to be known as "La Union Day". [When the holiday falls on a Saturday or a Sunday, or on a nationally declared nonworking holiday, the special nonworking day shall be observed on the next business day that follows.] UPON PROCLAMATION OF THE PRESIDENT,

MARCH 2 OF EVERY YEAR SHALL BE A SPECIAL NONWORKING HOLIDAY IN THE PROVINCE OF LA UNION.

- 1 SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication
- 2 in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
