COMMITTEE REPORT NO. 562

RE: House Bill No. 6512

Recommending its approval with amendments.

MR. PRESIDENT:

The Committees on Local Government; and Electoral Reforms and People's Participation, to which was referred **House Bill No. 6512,** introduced by Representative Ann K. Hofer, entitled:

"AN ACT CREATING A BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY TIMBABAUAN IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TUNGAWAN, PROVINCE OF ZAMBOANGA SIBUGAY"

have considered the same and have the honor to report it back to the Senate with the recommendation that it be approved with the following amendments: 1. On pages 1 and 2, delete lines 4-15 and lines 1-2, respectively, and in lieu thereof, insert a new Section to read as follows:

"SEC. 2. TERRITORIAL BOUNDARIES. – THE TERRITORIAL BOUNDARIES OF BARANGAY TIMBABAUAN SHALL BE IDENTIFIED AS FOLLOWS:

Bounded on the North, along line 3-4 by Barangay Gaycon; along line 4-5 by Barangay of Masao;

On the East, along lines 5-6-7 by Barangay Libertad;

On the South East, along lines 7-1 by Barangay Tigbanuang;

On the South West, along line 1-2 by Barangay of Upper Tungawan;

On the West, along line 2-3 by Barangay of Sisay, all of Tungawan Municipality, Tungawan Cadastre. PB-09-000019.

Beginning at a point of marked "1" on plan, being S. 47° 40' W., 5,467.792 meters from BLLM No. 1, Tungawan Cadastre;

thence N. 53° 34' W., 1,081.774 m to point 2; thence N. 18° 48' E., 5,609.756 m to point 3; thence S. 69° 09' E., 1,341.253 m to point 4; thence S. 62° 51' E., 899. 162 m to point 5; thence S. 01° 55' W., 1,991.571 m to point 6; thence S. 12° 18' E., 1,123.236 m to point 7; thence S. 57° 59' W., 3,730.534 m to point 1

AN ACT CREATING A BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY TIMBABAUAN IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TUNGAWAN, PROVINCE OF ZAMBOANGA SIBUGAY

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Creation of Barangay Timbabauan. - There is hereby
created a barangay to be known as Barangay Timbabauan in the Municipality
of Tungawan, Province of Zamboanga Sibugay.

The territorial boundaries of Barangay Timbabauan are hereby
described as follows:

"Beginning at a corner marked "1", due N 88° W; 890 meters to corner 6 7 2; thence, S 30° W; 300 meters to corner 3; thence, N 85° W, 280 meters to 8 corner 4; thence, N 60° W, 300 meters to corner 5; N 86° W, 600 meters to 9 corner 6; N 12° W, 960 meters to corner 7; N 28° E, 600 meters to corner 8; 10 S 79° E, 720 meters to corner 9; N 34° W, 400 meters to corner 10; N 41° E, 11 720 meters to corner 11; N 25° E, 340 meters to corner 12; N 35° E, 300 12 meters to corner 13; thence, due North, 1,100 meters to corner 14; N 87° E, 970 meters to corner 15; S 02°, 2,270 meters to corner 17; S 14° W, 500 13 14 meters to corner 18; thence, 102° W, 790 meters to point 1, the point of 15 beginning.

"Barangay Timbabauan covers an approximate area of 918.09
hectares."

SEC. 2. Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite. - The plebiscite 3 4 conducted and supervised by the Commission on Elections (COMELEC) pursuant to Provincial Ordinance No. 11, series of 1991, dated October 8, 5 1991 of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of the Province of 6 Zamboanga del Sur, which ratified the creation of Barangay Timbabauan 7 as proclaimed by the Plebiscite Board of Canvassers on December 2, 1994 8 9 shall serve as substantial compliance with the plebiscite requirement under Section 10 of Republic Act No. 7160, as amended, otherwise known 10 as the "Local Government Code of 1991". 11

SEC. 3. Incumbent Barangay Officials. - The incumbent barangay
officials of Barangay Timbabauan shall continue to hold office until such time
that their successors have been duly elected and qualified.

15 SEC. 4. Public Infrastructure and Facilities. - All existing public 16 infrastructure and facilities for public use therein at the time of the 17 approval of this Act are hereby transferred without cost or compensation 18 to and shall be administered by the new barangay.

SEC. 5. Internal Revenue Allotment Shares. - Barangay Timbabauan
shall be entitled to Internal Revenue Allotment shares pursuant to Section 285
of Republic Act No. 7160, as amended, otherwise known as the "Local
Government Code of 1991".

 SEC. 6. Effectivity. - This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
its publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation. Approved,
