APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. There is hereby established, under the supervision of
2 the Department of Education, a national high school in Barangay
3 Bagbaguin, Valenzuela City to be known as Bagbaguin National
4 High School.

5 SEC. 2. The Secretary of Education shall immediately include in the
6 Department's program the operationalization of the Bagbaguin
7 National High School, the funding of which shall be included
8 in the annual General Appropriations Act.

9 SEC. 3. The Secretary of Education shall formulate the rules and
10 regulations implementing the provisions of this Act within one hundred
11 twenty (120) days after its effectivity.

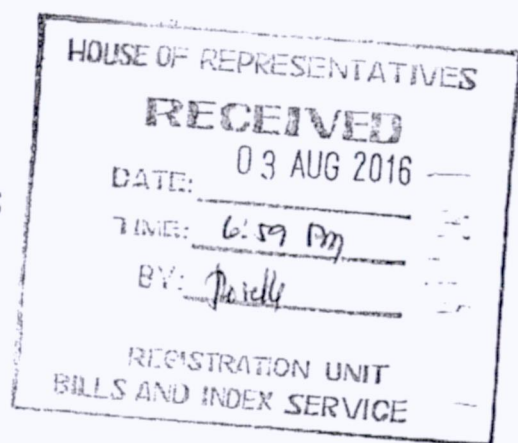
1 SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
2 publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of

EXPLANATORY NOTE
