AN ACT CHANGING THE NAME OF MANLABANG NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL IN BARANGAY MANLABANG, MUNICIPALITY OF CAIBIRAN, PROVINCE OF BILIRAN, TO CAIBIRAN NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- SECTION 1. The name of Manlabang National High School in Barangay Manlabang, Municipality of Caibiran, Province of Biliran, is hereby changed to Caibiran National High School.
- SEC. 2. The main campus of the Caibiran National High School shall continue to remain in its present location in Barangay Manlabang, Municipality of Caibiran, Province of Biliran.
- SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.

EXPLANATORY NOTE



The bill seeks to rename the Manlabang National High School located in Barangay Manlabang, Municipality of Caibiran, Province of Biliran to be known as Caibiran National High School and appropriating funds therefore.

There are only two (2) public senior high schools in Caibiran; the ICT High School of Eastern Biliran and the Manlabang National High School, the latter being the biggest Senior High School and cater secondary education in the whole Municipality, it is only proper to rename the institution to the namesake of the Municipality.

Furthermore, long before, the municipal leaders of Caibiran initiated and converted the school from Manlabang Barangay High School to Manlabang National High School. Therefore, it is only appropriate and timely to rename Manlabang National High School to Caibiran National High School.

In view of the foregoing, the passage of the Bill is earnestly sought.

#### AN ACT

RENAMING THE MANLABANG NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL IN BRGY. MANLABANG, MUNICIPALITY OF CAIBIRAN, PROVINCE OF BILIRAN INTO THE CAIBIRAN NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFORE

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Republic of the Philippines in the Congress assembled:

- **SECTION1.** Renaming of a National High School. The Manlabang National High School in Brgy. Manlabang, Municipality of Caibiran, Province of Biliran is hereby renamed and to be known as The Caibiran National High School.
- **SEC.2.** Implementing Rules and Regulations. The Secretary of the Department of Education shall promulgate and issue such rules and regulations as may be necessary to fully implement the provisions of this Act.
- **SEC. 3. Appropriations.** The amount necessary to carry out the implementation of this Act shall be included in the General Appropriations Act of the year following its enactment into laws and thereafter.
- SEC. 4. Repealing Clause. All laws, decrees, orders, rules and regulations and other issuances or parts thereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.
- SEC. 5. Effectivity. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its official publication in the Official Gazette.
