



AN ACT CONVERTING THE LICOP ELEMENTARY SCHOOL IN
BARANGAY LICOP, MATI CITY, PROVINCE OF DAVAO
ORIENTAL INTO AN INTEGRATED SCHOOL TO BE KNOWN
AS LICOP INTEGRATED SCHOOL AND APPROPRIATING
FUNDS THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. The Licop Elementary School in Barangay Licop, Mati
2 City, Province of Davao Oriental is hereby converted into an integrated school
3 to be known as Licop Integrated School.

4 SEC. 2. All personnel, assets, liabilities, and records of the Licop
5 Elementary School are hereby transferred to and absorbed by the Licop
6 Integrated School.

7 SEC. 3. The Secretary of Education shall immediately include in the
8 Department's program the operationalization of the Licop Integrated School,
9 the funding of which shall be included in the annual General Appropriations
10 Act.

1 SEC. 4. The Secretary of Education shall formulate the rules and
2 regulations implementing the provisions of this Act within one hundred
3 twenty (120) days after its effectivity.

4 SEC. 5. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication
5 in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
