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AN ACT ESTABLISHING A NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL IN  
BARANGAY CORPORACION, MUNICIPALITY OF LUPON,  
PROVINCE OF DAVAO ORIENTAL TO BE KNOWN  
AS CORPORACION NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL AND  
APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in  
Congress assembled:*

1           SECTION 1. There is hereby established, under the supervision  
2 of the Department of Education, a national high school in Barangay  
3 Corporacion, Municipality of Lupon, Province of Davao Oriental to  
4 be known as Corporacion National High School.

5           SEC. 2. The Secretary of Education shall immediately include  
6 in the Department's program the operationalization of the Corporacion  
7 National High School, the funding of which shall be included in the  
8 annual General Appropriations Act.

1           SEC. 3. The Secretary of Education shall formulate the rules and  
2 regulations implementing the provisions of this Act within one  
3 hundred twenty (120) days after its effectivity.

4           SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its  
5 publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of  
6 general circulation.
