AN ACT ESTABLISHING A NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL IN  
BARANGAY MAGDUG, MUNICIPALITY OF GOVERNOR  
GENEROSO, PROVINCE OF DAVAO ORIENTAL TO BE  
KNOWN AS MAGDUG NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL AND  
APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the  
Philippines in Congress assembled:*

1           SECTION 1. There is hereby established, under the  
2 supervision of the Department of Education, a national high school  
3 in Barangay Magdug, Municipality of Governor Generoso, Province  
4 of Davao Oriental to be known as Magdug National High School.

5           SEC. 2. The Secretary of Education shall immediately include  
6 in the Department's program the operationalization of the Magdug  
7 National High School, the funding of which shall be included in the  
8 annual General Appropriations Act.

9           SEC. 3. The Secretary of Education shall formulate the rules  
10 and regulations implementing the provisions of this Act within one  
11 hundred twenty (120) days after its effectivity.

1           SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its  
2 publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general  
3 circulation.
