The Committee on Education, Arts and Culture to which was referred House Bill No. 6523, introduced by Rep. Delloso-Montalla, C. P., *et. al*, entitled:

"AN ACT RENAMING THE RAMON MAGSAYSAY TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY (RMTU) AS THE PRESIDENT RAMON MAGSAYSAY STATE UNIVERSITY (PRMSU), EXPANDING ITS CURRICULAR OFFERINGS AND STRENGTHENING ITS GOVERNING BOARD, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE REPUBLIC ACT NO. 8498, ENTITLED: AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE RAMON MAGSAYSAY TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY OUT OF THE INTEGRATION OF THE RAMON MAGSAYSAY POLYTECHNIC COLLEGE IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF IBA, THE WESTERN LUZON AGRICULTURAL COLLEGE IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAN MARCELINO AND THE CANDELARIA SCHOOL OF FISHERIES IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF CANDELARIA, ALL IN THE PROVINCE OF ZAMBALES, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR"

AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE REPUBLIC ACT NO. 8498, ENTITLED: "AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE RAMON MAGSAYSAY TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY OF THE INTEGRATION OUT OF THE RAMON MAGSAYSAY POLYTECHNIC COLLEGE IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF IBA. THE WESTERN LUZON AGRICULTURAL COLLEGE IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAN MARCELINO AND THE CANDELARIA SCHOOL OF FISHERIES IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF CANDELARIA, ALL IN THE PROVINCE OF ZAMBALES, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR"

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- 1 SECTION 1. The Ramon Magsaysay Technological University
- 2 (RMTU) in the Province of Zambales is hereby renamed as the
- 3 President Ramon Magsaysay State University (PRMSU).

1 All references to Ramon Magsaysay Technological University 2 in Republic Act No. 8498 are now referred to as President Ramon 3 Magsaysay State University.

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SEC. 2. As a comprehensive state university, the President 5 Ramon Magsaysay State University (PRMSU), hereinafter referred 6 to as the University, shall primarily provide advance and higher 7 professional, technical and special instructions in education and 8 technology, engineering and architecture, agriculture, forestry and 9 fisheries, public administration and management, business and accountancy, economics and finance, tourism, hospitality and 10 11 culinary management, creative industries, humanities, arts and sciences, information and communications technology, maritime 12 13 education, law and legal management, medicine and health-related 14 programs, peace and security programs and other related fields of 15 study. It shall also undertake research and extension, as well as 16 income generation programs, for the sustainable development of the 17 Province of Zambales, the region and the country.

SEC. 3. The University shall offer undergraduate and 18 graduate programs in the fields of education, technology, 19 engineering and architecture, agriculture, forestry and fisheries, 20 public administration and management, business and accountancy, 21 22 economics and finance, tourism, hospitality and culinary 23 management, creative industries, humanities, arts and sciences, 24 information and communications technology, maritime education, 25 law and legal management, medicine and health-related programs, 26 peace and security programs and other relevant programs within its 27 areas of specialization and according to its capabilities, as the Board

of Regents may deem necessary to carry out its objectives, in order to meet the needs of the Province of Zambales, the region and the country.

4 SEC. 4. The governing board of the University shall be the 5 Board of Regents, hereinafter referred to as the Board, which shall 6 be composed of the following:

7 (a) The Chairperson of the Commission on Higher Education8 (CHED), Chairperson;

9 (b) The President of the President Ramon Magsaysay State10 University, Co-Chairperson;

(c) The Chairperson of the Committee on Education, Arts andCulture of the Senate, member;

13 (d) The Chairperson of the Committee on Higher and
14 Technical Education of the House of Representatives, member;

(e) The Regional Director of the National Economic and
Development Authority (NEDA), member;

17 (f) The Regional Director of the Department of Science and18 Technology (DOST), member;

(g) The Regional Director of the Department of Agriculture(DA), member;

(h) The President of the federation of alumni associations of
 the University, member;

(i) The President of the federation of student governments ofthe University, member;

(j) The President of the federation of faculty associations of
 the University, member;

1 (k) Three (3) prominent Chief Executive Officers (CEOs) of 2 duly recognized national or multinational corporations who have 3 distinguished themselves in the fields of specialization of the 4 University or who have entered into a partnership with the 5 University, members; and

(1) Two (2) prominent academicians in the Philippines who
have distinguished themselves in the fields of specialization of the
University through their publication and track record in research,
members.

10 The three (3) prominent CEOs and the two (2) prominent 11 academicians shall be chosen from among a list of at least five (5) 12 qualified persons respectively, as recommended by the search 13 committee of the University constituted by the University 14 President, in consultation with the Chairperson of the CHED, based 15 on normal standards and qualifications for the position.

16 The three (3) prominent CEOs and the two (2) prominent 17 academicians shall serve for a term of two (2) years and may be 18 reappointed by the Board of Regents for another term.

19 SEC. 5. The University shall be headed by a President, who 20 shall render full-time service. The President shall be appointed by 21 the Board, subject to the guidelines, qualifications and standards 22 set by the Board, upon recommendation of a duly constituted search committee: Provided, That in order to effect a smooth transition to a 23 comprehensive university, the incumbent President of the RMTU 24 shall serve as the first President of PRMSU until the end of his 25 26 current term.

SEC. 6. All assets, real and personal, personnel and records of 1 2 the RMTU, as well as the liabilities or obligations, are hereby transferred to the University: Provided, That the positions, rights 3 and security of tenure of the faculty members and personnel therein 4 employed under existing laws prior to the renaming shall be 5 respected: Provided, further, That the incumbents of the positions 6 shall remain in the same status until otherwise provided for by the 7 Board: Provided, finally, That the University shall also include an 8 upgrade or increase in its human resource component. 9

10 All parcels of land belonging to the government occupied by 11 the RMTU are hereby declared to be property of the University and 12 shall be titled under that name: *Provided*, That should the 13 University cease to exist or be abolished of should such parcels of 14 land be no longer needed by the University, the same shall revert to 15 the concerned local government unit (LGU) or to the Republic of the 16 Philippines, as the case may be.

SEC. 7. Sections 2, 3, 4, and 16 of Republic Act No. 8498 are
 deemed amended or modified accordingly.

19 SEC. 8. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its 20 publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general 21 circulation.
