EXPLANATORY NOTE

Under Section 5(2), Article XVI of the 1987 Philippine Constitution, it is stated that the State shall strengthen the patriotic spirit and nationalist consciousness of the military, and respect for people's rights in the performance of their duty. Moreover, the State shall show primary concern for adequate remuneration and benefits of the armed forces and its members.

In furtherance of the above-stated reason, the passage of this bill is earnestly sought.

AN ACT ENCOURAGING ALL THEATERS AND CINEMAS IN THE PHILIPPINES TO GRANT FREE ADMISSION OR ADMISSION AT DISCOUNT RATES TO MEMBERS OF THE PHILIPPINE MILITARY



SECTION 1. Declaration of Policy. – It is the declared policy of the State to strengthen the patriotic spirit and nationalist consciousness of the military, and respect for people's rights in the performance of their duty. Professionalism in the armed forces and adequate remuneration and benefits of its members shall be a prime concern of the State.

SECTION 2. Definition. –

- (a) "Philippine Military" refers to the active and inactive members of the Armed Forces of the Philippines.
- (b) "Theater or cinema" refers to an establishment devoted exclusively to the exhibition of motion pictures
- **SECTION 3.** *Tax deduction.* Theaters and cinemas that grant free admission or admission at discounted rates to members of the Philippine Military may claim them as tax deductions.
- **SECTION 4.** Exemption from Amusement Tax. In addition to the tax deduction under Section 3, the incentives granted by theaters and cinemas shall be exempt from any amusement tax under the National Internal Revenue Code, or any tax of similar nature on such kind of incentive that may be imposed by Local Government Units under the law.
- **SECTION 5.** *Implementing Rules and Regulations.* The BIR shall issue rules and regulations for the effective implementation of this Act.
- **SECTION 6.** Repealing Clause. All laws, decrees, executive orders, proclamations, rules and regulations and other issuance of parts thereof, inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.
