AN ACT INCREASING THE BED CAPACITY OF THE BAGUIO GENERAL HOSPITAL AND MEDICAL CENTER FROM FIVE HUNDRED (500) TO EIGHT HUNDRED (800) BEDS AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- SECTION 1. The bed capacity of the Baguio General Hospital and Medical Center (BGHMC) in Baguio City is hereby increased from five hundred (500) to eight hundred (800).
- SEC. 2. The existing service facilities and professional health care services are also hereby upgraded to conform with and be commensurate to the bed capacity increase as provided in Section 1 hereof.
- SEC. 3. The existing workforce of the BGHMC shall also be correspondingly increased. The Department of Health, in coordination with the Department of Budget and Management and the Civil Service Commission, shall determine the additional plantilla positions to be created and filled up upon prior consultation with the BGHMC.

1	SEC. 4. The increase in bed capacity of the BGHMC from five					
2	hundred (500) to eight hundred (800) beds shall be implemented for a period					
3	of not more than three (3) years from the approval of this Act.					
4	SEC. 5. The Secretary of Health shall immediately include in the					
5	Department's programs the implementation of this Act, the funding of which					
6	shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.					
7	SEC. 6. Republic Act No. 8634, otherwise known as "An Act					
8	Increasing the Bed Capacity of the Baguio General Hospital and Medical					
9	Center, Located in Baguio City, from Four Hundred (400) to Five Hundred					
10	(500) Beds, Upgrading the Service-Facilities and Professional Health Care					
11	Therein, and Appropriating Funds Therefor", is hereby repealed.					
12	SEC. 7. This Act shall take effect within fifteen (15) days after its					
13	publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
