HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

By Representatives Aumentado and Nograles (K.A.), per Committee Report No. 590

AN ACT INCREASING THE BED CAPACITY OF DON EMILIO DEL VALLE MEMORIAL HOSPITAL (DEDVMH) IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF UBAY, PROVINCE OF BOHOL FROM FIFTY (50) TO THREE HUNDRED (300) BEDS, UPGRADING ITS SERVICES AND FACILITIES AND PROFESSIONAL HEALTH CARE, AUTHORIZING THE INCREASE OF ITS MEDICAL PERSONNEL, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- SECTION 1. The authorized bed capacity of the Don Emilio
  Del Valle Memorial Hospital (DEDVMH) in the Municipality
  Glubay, Province of Bohol is hereby increased from fifty (50)
  to three hundred (300) beds.
  - SEC. 2. The existing service facilities and professional health care services of the DEDVMH are hereby upgraded to conform with and be commensurate to the bed capacity as herein provided for.
  - SEC. 3. The existing workforce of the DEDVMH shall be correspondingly increased. Upon prior consultation with the DEDVMH, the Department of Health (DOH), in coordination with

1	the Department of Budget and Management and the Civil Service
2	Commission, shall determine the additional plantilla positions to be
3	created pursuant to this Act.

SEC. 4. The increase in bed capacity of the DEDVMH from fifty (50) to three hundred (300) shall be implemented for a period of three (3) years from the approval of this Act.

SEC. 5. The Secretary of the DOH shall immediately include in the Department's programs the implementation of this Act, the funding of which shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act.

SEC. 6. Section 1 of Republic Act No. 8693, entitled "An Act Establishing a Fifty-Bed Extension of the Gov. Celestino Gallares Memorial Regional Training Hospital in the Municipality of Ubay, Province of Bohol, to be Known as the Don Emilio Del Valle Memorial Hospital, and Appropriating Funds Therefor", is hereby amended accordingly.

SEC. 7. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
