Recommending its approval with amendments.

MR. PRESIDENT:

The Committees on Education, Arts and Culture and Finance to which was referred House Bill No. 6030, introduced by Rep. Abellanosa, R., et. al. entitled:

"AN ACT

INTEGRATING THE CEBU CITY MOUNTAIN EXTENSION CAMPUS AS A SATELLITE CAMPUS OF THE CEBU TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE REPUBLIC ACT NO. 9744, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS AN ACT CONVERTING THE CEBU STATE COLLEGE OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY SYSTEM IN THE CITY OF CEBU AND ALL ITS SATELLITE CAMPUSES LOCATED IN THE PROVINCE OF CEBU INTO A STATE UNIVERSITY TO BE KNOWN AS THE CEBU TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY (CTU) AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR"

has considered the same and has the honor to report it back to the Senate with the recommendation that it be approved with the following amendments:

1. ON PAGE 2, INSERT A NEW SECTION, SECTION 2, BETWEEN LINES 17 AND 18, TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

"SEC. 2. ASSETS, LIABILITIES AND PERSONNEL. ALL ASSETS, REAL AND PERSONAL, PERSONNEL AND RECORDS OF THE CEBU CITY MOUNTAIN EXTENSION CAMPUS, AS WELL AS LIABILITIES OR OBLIGATIONS, ARE HEREBY TRANSFERRED TO THE UNIVERSITY. THE POSITIONS, RIGHT AND SECURITY OF TENURE OF FACULTY MEMBERS AND PERSONNEL THEREIN EMPLOYED UNDER EXISTING

LAWS PRIOR TO THE CONVERSION INTO A UNIVERSITY SHALL BE RESPECTED.

ALL PARCELS OF LAND BELONGING TO THE GOVERNMENT OCCUPIED BY THE CEBU CITY MOUNTAIN EXTENSION CAMPUS ARE HEREBY DECLARED TO BE THE PROPERTY OF THE UNIVERSITY AND SHALL BE TITLED UNDER ITS NAME; *PROVIDED*, THAT SHOULD THE UNIVERSITY CEASE TO EXIST OR BE ABOLISHED OR SHOULD SUCH PARCELS OF LAND AFOREMENTIONED BE NO LONGER NEEDED BY THE UNIVERSITY, THE SAME SHALL REVERT TO THE LGUS CONCERNED."

- 2. RE-NUMBER THE SUCCEEDING SECTIONS ACCORDINGLY.
- 3. ON PAGES 2 AND 3, LINES 20 AND 11, RESPECTIVELY, REMOVE THE BRACKETS DELETING THE PROVISION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled.

Section 1 Section 1 of Republic Act No. 9744 is hereby amended to read as follows

"SECTION 1. Conversion: The Cebu State College of Science and Technology System in the City of Cebu, including

all its existing satellite campuses, namely the College of Lisheries in the Municipality of Moalboal, the Agro-industrial and Forestry College in the Municipality of Argao, the Polytechnic College in the Municipality of Luburan, the College of Fisheries in the Municipality of Daanbantayan, the Fishery

and Industrial College in the Municipality of San Francisco, the College of Industrial Technology in the Municipality of Danao. the College of Lisheries Technology in the Municipality of Carmen, the Abeliana College of Arts and Trades in the City of Mandaue, the College of Agriculture in the Manicipality of Barili (previously located in Sudlon, Lahug of Cebu City) and the Experimental Station in the Municipality of Sibonga, all municipalities located in the Province of Cebu, [are] is hereby converted into a state university to be known as the Cebu Feetmological University (CTU), hereinafter referred to as the University THE CEBE CITY MOUNTAIN EXTENSION CAMPUS IN BARANGAY BABAG, CEBU CHY, PROVINCE OF CEBU, IS INTEGRATED AS A SATULLITE CAMPUS OF THE CEBU TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY. IT SHALL BE KNOWN AS THE CEBU TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY - CEBU CHY MOUNTAIN SATELLITE CAMPUS. The main campus of the University shall be in Cebu City

Sec. 2. Section 20 of the same Act is hereby amended to read as follows:

See 20. Appropriations. The amount necessary to carry out the provisions of this Act shall be charged against the current year's appropriations of the Cebu State College of Science and Technology System, including all its existing satellite campuses, namely the College of Fisheries in the Municipality of Moalboal, the Agro-industrial and Forestry College in the Municipality of Argao, the Polytechnic College in the Municipality of Tuburan, the College of Fisheries in the Municipality of Daanbantavan, the Fishery and Industrial

College in the Municipality of San Francisco, the College of Industrial Technology in the Municipality of Danao, the College of Eisheries Technology in the Municipality of Carmen, the Abellana College of Arts and Frades in the City of Mandaue, the College of Agriculture in the Municipality of Barili and the Experimental Station in the Municipality of Sibonga, except the sums needed to continue the operations of the existing high schools. Thereafter, such sums as may be necessary for the continued operation and maintenance of the Cebu Technological University shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act. THE AMOUNT NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THE INITIAL IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS INTEGRATION OF THE CEBU CHY MOUNTAIN EXTENSION CAMPUS SHALL BE CHARGED AGAINST THE CURRENT YEAR'S FUNDING OF THE CEBU CITY MOUNTAIN EXTENSION CAMPUS PROVIDED BY THE CITY OF CEBU. THE CITY SHALL CONTINUE TO PROVIDE THE SAME FUNDING TO THE CEBU CITY MOUNTAIN EXTENSION CAMPUS CORRESPONDING TO THE FUNDING GIVEN BEFORE THE SAME IS INTEGRATED INTO THE CEBT TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY UNTIL SUCH TIME THAT THE FULL FUNDING REQUIREMENT OF THE CEBI TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY - CEBT CITY MOUNTAIN EXTENSION CAMPUS IS INCLUDED IN THE ANNUAL GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS ACT.

SEC. 3. Effectivity. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its complete publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
